January 2021 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the January 2021 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a bumper crop of bird books that were announced in December 2020. The biggest highlight this month is Europe's Birds: An Identification Guide, due May from WILDGuides. Other notable field guides are the just-published Birds and Mammals of the Galapagos from Lynx, the second edition of An Identification Guide to Birds of Britain and Northern Europe, due May from John Beaufoy Publishing, and the second edition of Southern African LBJs Made Simple, due April from Penguin Random House South Africa. Closer to home we have stock of the privately published Birds of Chew Valley Lake: Ecology, History, Tales, while Bloomsbury has announced RSPB ID Spotlight: Woodland Birds for June.

For mammals and reptiles we have one title each. We are reannouncing <u>The Arabian Leopards of Oman</u> that was first announced in our January 2014 Monthly Catalogue but has been unavailable for some time. We have been able to get hold of unsold stock that was held in Oman by the author, so if you missed out the first time around, now is your opportunity. Not yet published is <u>The Secret Social Lives of Reptiles</u>, due June from Johns Hopkins University Press.

We have some exceptional entomological titles this month. NAP Editions has just published Sawflies of Europe, the second volume in their Hymenoptera of Europe series. In June, Princeton University Press will publish Ant Architecture: The Wonder, Beauty, and Science of Underground Nests and Bloomsbury will publish RSPB ID Spotlight: Caterpillars. Not entomology, but of interest to arachnologists is

Water Mittes of the World: With Keys to the Families, Subfamilies, Genera and Subgenera (Acari: Hydrachnidia), published by The Netherlands Entomological Society, which is in stock.

On the topic of botany we have two notable titles: Jungle: How Tropical Forests Shaped the World - and Us, due July from Viking, and Finding the Mother Tree: Uncovering the Wisdom and Intelligence of the Forest, due May from Allen Lane. The latter is written by Suzanne Simard and straddles the border between botany and mycology, as it discusses the underground network of fungi that links plants. Further mycology titles come from KNNV in the Netherlands in the shape of two unmodified reprints of the Dutch mushroom field guides Veldgids Paddenstoelen I, which covers Agaricales and Boletes, and Veldgids Paddenstoelen II, which covers the Pezizomycetes, gasteroid fungi, club fungi, coral fungi, Meruliaceae, Hydnaceae, and Tremellales.

To round out this month's selection we have a smattering of subjects. Environmental history: we are reannouncing

The Fishmeal Revolution: The Industrialization of the Humboldt Current Ecosystem, due June from the University of California Press. This was originally announced in our July 2018 Monthly Catalogue, then cancelled by the publisher, and has now been reannounced with new ISBNs. Palaeontology: Columbia University Press will publish Locked in Time: Animal Behavior Unearthed in 50 Extraordinary Fossils in June. Animal behaviour: Cambridge University Press will publish the fourth edition of Measuring Behaviour: An Introductory Guide in May. Popular science: Bloomsbury will publish

The Brilliant Abyss: True Tales of Exploring the Deep Sea, Discovering Hidden Life and Selling the Seabed in February, and Oxford University Press will publish Secret Worlds: The Extraordinary Senses of Animals in June.
