Welcome to the January 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

There are three noteworthy upcoming bird books: In June, Bloomsbury will publish the paperback of The Glitter in the Green: In Search of Hummingbirds and Birds of the Lesser Antilles, a new addition to their Helm Wildlife Guides series, while Springer has just published the paperback of Behavioural Ecology of Western Palearctic Falcons. For other vertebrate groups, we have one fish book this month with The Ecology and Biogeography of Sri Lanka: A Context for Freshwater Fishes, just published by Wildlife Heritage Trust Publications.

On the subject of insects and other invertebrate groups, we have some fantastic titles coming from Princeton University Press with

Stingless Bees: Their Behaviour, Ecology and Evolution, while ConchBooks has published two new volumes in their series The Conchological Albums – Terrestrial

Molluscs: Volume 5: Bulimulidae (2), Camaenidae (1), and Volume 6: Camaenidae (2).

We have a bumper crop of botany titles. Wild Nature Press is publishing Field Guide to Coastal Wildflowers of Britain, Ireland and Northwest Europe in May and HarperCollins has announced the next New Naturalist for April, simply titled Trees. Two paperback reissues are

Finding the Mother Tree: Uncovering the Wisdom and Intelligence of the Forest, due March from Penguin Books, and The White Birch: A Russian Reflection, due June from Corsair. Lastly, the Paris Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle has just published

Enraciner l'Empire: Une Autre Histoire du Jardin Botanique de Calcutta (1860-1910) [Grounding the Empire: Another Story of the Calcutta Botanical Garden (1860-1910)]. Two noteworthy mycology titles are The Lives of Fungi: A Natural History of Our Planet's Decomposers, due April from Princeton University Press, and The Mycocultural Revolution: Transforming Our World with Mushrooms, Lichens, and Other Fungi, due March from Microcosm Publishing.

On the topics of wildlife conservation and other environmental issues, we similarly have some strong titles to announce. In June, Witness Book will publish Rewilding the Sea: How to Save Our Oceans by Charles Clover (author of The End of the Line), Yale University Press will publish Security and Conservation: The Politics of the Illegal Wildlife Trade, and Oxford University Press will publish

Paul's The Princeton Field Guide to Pterosaurs in June. Then a smattering of diverse but highly interesting titles: Princeton University Press is publishing When Animals Dream: The Hidden World of Animal Consciousness in May, The Bodley Head has announced Ed Yong's An Immense World: How Animal Senses Reveal the Hidden Realms Around Us for June, HarperCollins is publishing The Sloth Lemur's Song: Madagascar's Deep Past to Its Uncertain Present in March, and Picador is releasing the paperback of Carl Zimmer's Life's Edge: The Search for What It Means to Be Alive in June.
