February 2021 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the February 2021 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a smattering of titles this month dealing with various vertebrate groups. For ornithologists and birdwatchers, we have exciting news from Lynx, who will publish Seabirds: The New Identification Guide in March. Two of its three authors, Peter Harrison and Hans Larsson, have previously written field guides on seabirds. Other interesting titles are Martin Painter's personal Birding in an Age of Extinctions, due June from Whittles Publishing, and the academic Migration Strategies of Birds of Prey in Western Palearctic, due July from CRC Press. For herpetologists, we have A Guide to the Reptiles and Amphibians of Iran just published by Chimaira and the sixth edition of A Complete Guide to Reptiles of Australia just published by New Holland. A general guide that is now in stock is the bilingual English-French Terrestrial Fauna of the Comoros Archipelago.

We have a bumper selection of entomology titles this month, skewed towards insects found in Britain. Pelagic Publishing will release

A Field Guide to Harlequins and Other Common Ladybirds of Britain and Ireland in March while the Field Studies Council has just published a new BRC Atlas,
The Histeridae, Sphaeritidae and Silphidae of Britain and Ireland. More regional titles are Butterflies of Cornwall: Atlas for the Twenty-first Century, due May from
NatureBureau, and, just published, The Bees, Wasps and Ants of Lancashire from the Lancashire & Cheshire Fauna Society. Venturing into Europe we have
Dragonflies and Damselflies of Britain and Western Europe, due May from Bloomsbury, which is an English translation of an originally French guide. Lastly, Dave Goulson is writing Gardening for Bumblebees: A Practical Guide to Creating a Paradise for Pollinators that will be published in April by Square Peg.

Briefly, two titles on molluscs are the new Ray Society monograph Biology, Evolution and Generic Review of the Chemosymbiotic Bivalve Family Lucinidae, and a new Visaya Supplement published by ConchBooks in Germany: Little Conoidean Shells from Dhofar, Oman, with Description of 35 New Species.

Turning to botany there are some great books lined up. In April, Missouri Botanical Garden Press will publish <u>Driven by Nature: A Personal Journey from Shanghai to Botany and Global Sustainability, which is the autobiography of prominent scientist and conservationist Peter H. Raven. Harper Collins will publish the paperback of <u>Planting the World: Joseph Banks and His Collectors: An Adventurous History of Botany in July. Two noteworthy field guides are Start to Identify Composite Flowers: Daisy, Dandelion, Thistle, a new addition to the series of pocket-sized field guides written by Faith Anstey which is due in March, and the second edition of The Wildflowers of Ireland: A Field Guide, due May from Gill & Macmillan.</u></u>

We have five noteworthy titles this month on the subject of ecology and conservation. Ecosystem Collapse and Recovery, due March, is a new addition to Cambridge University Press's Ecology, Biodiversity and Conservation series. Johns Hopkins University Press, meanwhile, keeps expanding its Wildlife Management and Conservation series, with the latest additions being Applications for Advancing Animal Ecology and Wildlife Management and Landscapes: Principles and Applications, both due in July. (If you want to set up a standing order for these or other series, please contact our customer services team!) Lastly, we have stock of the French protected areas atlas Atlas des Espaces Protégés en France: Des Territoires en Partage? that was published recently by the Paris Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle.

Four books on climate change and other environmental issues we are looking forward to are Alice Bell's <u>Our Biggest Experiment: A History of the Climate Crisis</u>, due July from Bloomsbury, and Mark Maslin's <u>How To Save Our Planet: The Facts</u>, due May from Penguin Books. Two paperback reprints of note are Stephen Moss's <u>The Accidental Countryside: Hidden Havens for Britain's Wildlife</u>, due April from Faber & Faber, and the recently published <u>Meat Planet: Artificial Flesh and the Future of Food from the University of California Press.</u>

On the topics of evolutionary biology and palaeontology we have two paperback reissues worth mentioning: <u>Humankind: A Hopeful History</u>, due May from Bloomsbury, and <u>The Smart Neanderthal: Cave Art, Bird Catching & the Cognitive Revolution</u>, due July from Oxford University Press.

For those looking for good nature writing we have The Wild Isles: An Anthology of the Best of British & Irish Nature Writing, edited by Patrick Barkham, coming in March from Head of Zeus, and paperback reprints of Diary of a Young Naturalist, due April from Ebury Press, and Richard Mabey's Turning the Boat for Home: A Life Writing about Nature, due March from Vintage. The Library of America will publish

E. O. Wilson: Biophilia, The Diversity of Life, Naturalist in March, which bundles these three classics in an affordable format and will feature an introduction by David Quammen.

Rounding off we have a miscellany of four titles. Pelagic Publishing has just announced <u>Better Posters: Plan, Design and Present an Academic Poster</u> for April. Three books particularly relevant to the pandemic are <u>How to Make a Vaccine</u>: An <u>Essential Guide for COVID-19 & Beyond</u> and an updated edition of Carl Zimmer's now-classic work of popular science <u>A Planet of Viruses</u>, which are both due March from the University of Chicago Press, plus <u>Viruses</u>, <u>Pandemics</u>, and <u>Immunity</u>, due this month from MIT Press.
