February 2022 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the February 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

This time we have some excellent mammal titles. Johns Hopkins University Press will publish Methods for Ecological Research on Terrestrial Small Mammals in February while Pelagic Publishing has announced The Hair Scale Identification Guide to Terrestrial Mammalian Carnivores of Canada for June. Two new bat books are Identification Guide to Ireland's Bats from the National Biodiversity Data Centre which is now in stock, and A Miscellany of Bats, due May from Pelagic Publishing. There are three bird titles in the pipeline. Johns Hopkins University Press has announced Bird Migration: A New Understanding for February; William Collins will publish In Search of One Last Song: Britain's Disappearing Birds and the People Trying to Save Them in April; and KNNV in the Netherlands has plans for a large two-volume set, Handbook Europese Vogels: Alle Kenmerken in Beeld [Handbook of European Birds: All Characteristics in Pictures], to be released in March. Two new titles on marine fauna are Rock Pools, a new addition to the Naturalists' Handbooks series due in May from Pelagic Publishing, and Ireland's Biodiversity: Marine Bivalve Shells, an identification swatch from the National Biodiversity Data Centre that is in stock now.

There are also some great insect titles coming. William Collins has announced Endless Forms: The Secret World of Wasps for April while SANBI has just released Manual of Afrotropical Diptera, Volume 3: Brachycera - Cyclorrhapha, Excluding Calyptratae - Higher Diptera. We have stock of The Social Wasps of North America from Owlfly Publishing, the privately published The Irish Butterfly Book: A Complete Guide to the Butterflies of Ireland, and Papilionidae Part 3 (Guide to the Butterflies of the Palearctic Region): Subfamily Parnassiinae, Tribes Zerynthiini and Luehdorfiini from Omnes Artes.

For botanists, we have several nice popular titles, including Where the Wildflowers Grow: My Botanical Journey Through Britain and Ireland, due June from Hodder & Stoughton, and the paperbacks of The Heartbeat of Trees: Embracing Our Ancient Bond with Forests and Nature, due March from William Collins, and Jungle: How Tropical Forests Shaped the World - and Us, due July from Viking Books. We also have stock of Ireland's Biodiversity: Intertidal Seaweeds, another identification swatch from the National Biodiversity Data Centre. For mycologists we have Larger Fungi in Eastern Tropical Africa: A Field Guide, published by the Finnish Museum of Natural History, and The Hidden Kingdom of Fungi: Exploring the Microscopic World in Our Forests, Homes, and Bodies, due July from Greystone Books.

On the topic of conservation we have Pelagus National Park: Biodiversity Above the Rapids, just released by Natural History Publications Borneo, and Cornerstones: Wild Forces That Can Change Our World, due July from Bloomsbury. Then there is a long list of paperback rereleases. In March there is Tapestries of Life: Uncovering the Lifesaving Secrets of the Natural World from Mudlark, in April Gone: A Search for What Remains of the World's Extinct Creatures from Aurum Press and Beloved Beasts: Fighting for Life in an Age of Extinction from W.W. Norton, in May A Trillion Trees: How We Can Reforest Our World from Granta, and in July The Book of Hope: A Survival Guide for Trying Times from Viking Books. Lastly, one book on climate change is Pandora's Toolbox: The Hopes and Hazards of Climate Intervention, due March from Cambridge University Press.

There are also some fantastic evolution and palaeontology books coming up. Picador will publish Steve Brusatte's The Rise and Reign of the Mammals in June (a follow-up to his popular The Rise and Fall of the Dinosaurs), while the paperback of The Story of Evolution in 25 Discoveries: The Evidence and the People Who Found It is due July from Columbia University Press. More technical is Cryptic Species: Morphological Stasis, Circumscription, and Hidden Diversity, due July from Cambridge University Press, while Siri Scientific Press will publish the more whimsical Jurassic Fossils of the West Dorset Coast: A Time Traveller's Journal this month.

Finally, two miscellaneous titles from Pelagic Publishing, both due June, are Rhythms of Nature: Wildlife and Wild Places Between the Moors and Wildlife Photography Fieldcraft.

As always, if you are looking for a particular title that we do not yet have in our range, or you would like to suggest a title for NHBS to stock, please do get in touch. In the meantime, a happy new year from all of us at NHBS, stay safe and keep well.
