Welcome to the April 2018 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a particularly strong list of bird titles this month. For UK birdwatchers we can offer [Birds of the Brecks](#) that was just published by the BTO, the recently published [Surrey Bird Atlas 2007-2012](#) and [Scarce and Rare Birds in North Wales](#). Safe Haven Books will publish [Birdwatching London: All the Best Places to See Birds in the Capital](#) in May. The BTO also just published [Nestboxes: Your Complete Guide](#). International birdwatchers can look forward to John Beaufoy's [The 125 Best Bird Watching Sites in Southeast Asia](#) in August, which is an updated edition of The 100 Best Birdwatching Sites in Southeast Asia. This publisher will furthermore release [Australia's Birdwatching Megaspots: The 65 Best Birdwatching Sites in Australia](#), and a third edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Borneo: Sabah, Sarawak, Brunei and Kalimantan](#), both due in August. Lastly, Roger White is about to publish a second edition of [A Birdwatching Guide to North East Germany and its Baltic Coast](#). Armchair ornithologists will no doubt be interested in [The Flying Zoo: Birds, Parasites, and the World They Share](#) from the University of Alberta Press, and [The Ravenmaster: Life with the Ravens at the Tower of London](#) from Harper Collins, both due September.

Those interested in mammals have [Handbook of the Mammals of the World, Volume 8: Insectivores, Sloths and Colugos](#) to look forward to in June, which follows only half a year after Lynx published volume 7. This is the penultimate volume in the series, although it remains to be seen whether the final volume on bats will be split out over several books as happened for the rodents. As soon as we know more about this we will update our website accordingly. John Beaufoy has announced a second edition of [Phillipps' Field Guide to the Mammals of Borneo and their Ecology: Sabah, Sarawak, Brunei and Kalimantan](#) for August. We furthermore have several interesting narratives, such as Regan Arts's [Lion Hearted: The Life and Death of Cecil & the Future of Africa's Iconic Cats](#), Sasquatch Books's [Return Of The Sea Otter: The Story of the Animal That Evaded Extinction on the Pacific Coast](#), and a reissue from Penguin Books in May of [A Prickly Affair: My Life with Hedgehogs](#), written by hedgehog doyen Hugh Warwick.

For botanists, we can recommend the BTO's [Flowers of the Brecks, Part 1: Heath & Grassland](#), out now, and John Beaufoy's [A Naturalist's Guide to the Flowers of Sri Lanka](#) and Ivy Press's [How Plants Work: An Exploration of Morphology, Diversity, and Survival in the Plant Kingdom](#), both due August.

If you are interested in insects and other invertebrates, Ivy Press is publishing [Octopus, Squid & Cuttlefish: The Worldwide Illustrated Guide to Cephalopods](#) in August. We furthermore have stock of [Pug Moths of North-West England: A Guide on Identification and Distribution in Cheshire, Lancashire and Cumbria](#). Other forthcoming titles are [A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies of Singapore](#) from John Beaufoy in August, [Buzz: The Nature and Necessity of Bees](#) from Icon Books in July, and a paperback reprint of [The Secret Life of Flies](#) from the London Natural History Museum in April.

Conservationists can look forward to [Extreme Conservation: Life at the Edges of the World](#) from the University of Chicago Press in August, [Birds of Prey: Biology and Conservation in the XXI Century](#) from Springer in June, and [Urban Raptors: Ecology and Conservation of Birds of Prey in Cities](#) from Island Press in August.

Readers of palaeontology and evolutionary biology will be spoiled for choice over the next few months. David Quammen is working on [The Tangled Tree: A Radical New History of Life](#), due in September from Harper Collins, which describes the ubiquity of horizontal gene transfer. Columbia University Press will publish [Carboniferous Giants and Mass Extinction: The Late Paleozoic Ice Age World](#) in September, Siri Scientific Press will publish [Trilobites of the British Isles](#) in June, and Oxford University Press will publish [Evolution and Selection of Quantitative Traits](#) in July, the second book in a planned trilogy summarising the field of quantitative genetics, the first volume of which was published in 1998. Finally, the very readable [The Ends of the World: Volcanic Apocalypses, Lethal Oceans and Our Quest to Understand Earth's Past Mass Extinctions](#) will be reissued in paperback by Oneworld Publications in September.

Finally, we have a selection of titles of general interest. We now stock the [Good Wildlife Travel Guide to India, Nepal and Bhutan](#). John Beaufoy will publish [A Naturalist's Guide to the Dangerous Creatures of Australia](#) in August. Mascot Media is about to release [Pressing On: A Decade of New Linocuts](#), showcasing the work of wildlife artist Robert Gillmor, famed for illustrating many New Naturalist covers. Little Toller will release [Cornerstones: Subterranean Writings; from Dartmoor to the Arctic Circle](#) in July, the University of Arizona Press has just published [A Natural History of the Mojave Desert](#), and last but not least, Harper Collins has announced the next new Naturalist (after Hedgehogs): [The Burren](#), which is due August. All customers who have standing orders with us for this series will naturally receive a notification nearer the time of publication.
