April 2021 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the May 2021 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a diverse range of bird books this month. The Luxembourgish publisher natur&ëmwelt has published an English translation of Birds of Luxembourg that is now in stock. From John Beaufoy we have second editions of A Naturalias's Guide to the Birds of Hong Kong and The 100 Best Birdwatching Sites in Australia, both due August. Another site guide is the 2021 reprint of A Birdwatching Guide to the Netherlands from author Roger White that features minor corrections and some new maps. The phenomenal Owls of the Eastern Ice: The Quest to Find and Save the World's Largest Owl will be released in paperback in October by Penguin Books. Another book dealing with birds in Russia is A Wild Bird and a Cultured Man: The Common Eider and Homo sapiens: Fourteen Centuries Together, written and published by Alexandra Goryashko, which is in stock now. On the subject of bird behaviour, CSIRO will publish Bird Talk: An Exploration of Avian Communication in May.

For other vertebrate groups, there are a few books worth mentioning. Wild Nature Press will publish the second edition of <u>A Pocket Guide to Sharks of the World</u> in July, while the paperback of Salmon: A Fish, the Earth, and the History of a Common Fate is due in October from Oneworld Publications. Chimaira will publish

Status and Threats of Afrotropical Amphibians: Status of Conservation and Decline of Amphibians: Eastern Hemisphere: Sub-Saharan Africa, Madagascar, Western Indian Ocean Islands, which is volume 11, part 7 in the series <u>Amphibian Biology</u>. John Beaufoy, then, has announced <u>Wildlife of the Australian Rainforests</u>: A State-By-State Guide for August.

There are some fantastic insect field guides in the works. Comstock will publish Pocket Guide to the Insects of Costa Rica in October and Dragonflies and Damselflies of Costa Rica: A Field Guide in May. Bloomsbury is inaugurating a new series of spiralbound guides, starting in September with British Moths: A Gateway Guide. Natural History Publications Borneo has just published A Taxonomic Guide to the Stick Insects of Sumatra, Volume 2, which is the sixth in their series of Taxonomic Guides to the Stick Insects of South East Asia. Practising entomologists and insect collectors of any stripe will welcome Specimen-Making and Preservation of Invertebrates that has just been published by Chimaira. And if you are looking for an exciting read, the paperback of The Language of Butterflies: How Thieves, Hoarders, Scientists, and Other Obsessives Unlocked the Secrets of the World's Favorite Insect is due July from Simon & Schuster

Botanists will be very pleased with the just-published Grasses: A Guide to Identification Using Vegetative Characters, a new AIDGAP guide from the Field Studies Council. By using vegetative characters rather than flower heads as diagnostic criteria, this guide allows fieldwork during a larger part of the year. Kew Publishing will release the second edition of their Field Guide to the Wild Flowers of the Western Mediterranean in September, and Pelagic Publishing has announced Brown Seaweeds (Phaeophyceae) of Britain and Ireland for October, which is the culmination of 30 years of studies by the author. Mycologists can look out for the paperback of Merlin Sheldrake's Entangled Life: How Fungi Make Our Worlds, Change Our Minds and Shape Our Futures in September from Vintage. Of local interest is A Provisional Census Catalogue of the Myxomycetes of the Forest of Dean, which has just been published by the Gloucestershire Naturalists' Society.

There are many outstanding titles on the topic of conservation and environmental issues this month. Dave Goulson is writing Silent Earth: Averting the Insect Apocalypse, due August from Jonathan Cape. September will see Conservation Technology from Oxford University Press and Ancient Woods, Trees and Forests: Ecology, History and Management from Pelagic Publishing, while Siri Scientific Press is publishing Why Conservation Isn't Working: Understanding Wildlife in the Modern World in July. The important topic of collective responsibility is receiving increasing attention, with the University of Chicago Press publishing We Are All Whalers: The Plight of Whales and Our Responsibility in October and Saraband releasing Extraction to Extinction: Rethinking our Relationship with Earth's Natural Resources in September. Springer, meanwhile, has just published the paperback of Planetary Accounting: Quantifying How to Live Within Planetary Limits at Different Scales of Human Activity. Lastly, Atlantic Books has announced Hot Air: The Inside Story of the Battle Against Climate Change Denial for October, written by MET Science Fellow Peter Stott.

Finally, a selection of titles across a range of subjects. For readers interested in environmental history there are Amitav Ghosh's

The Nutmeg's Curse: Parables for a Planet in Crisis, due October from Hodder & Stoughton, and the paperback of Myxomatosis: A History of Pest Control and the Rabbit, published by Bloomsbury Academic. Ecologists can look forward to a new New Naturalist with Ecology and Natural History, due June from HarperCollins, and Oak Seed Dispersal: A Study in Plant-Animal Interactions, which has just been published by Johns Hopkins University Press. Readers interested in evolution will enjoy the paperback of The Evolution of Feathers: From Their Origin to the Present, published by Springer. For those interested in palaeontology, the University of Chicago Press has a treat in store for September that combines palaeobotany and art: Tropical Arctic: Lost Plants, Future Climates, and the Discovery of Ancient Greenland. Last, but certainly not least, HarperCollins is releasing a fully updated edition of Sir David Attenborough's The Living Planet: A Portrait of the Earth in October.
