April 2022 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the April 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

There are a number of fine bird titles in the works. In September, Bloomsbury will publish <u>The Tawny Owl</u>, part of their long-running Poyser Monographs series, and <u>Birds of South Africa</u>, part of their new Helm Wildlife Guides series. Another identification guide is <u>Gulls of North America</u>, due April from Schiffer. The History Press is publishing the paperback of How to Read a Bird in June, while <u>Bird Photographer of the Year</u>, <u>Collection 7</u> is due in September from HarperCollins.

There are two noteworthy mammal titles this month. Pelagic Publishing will release the second edition of Social Calls of the Bats of Britain and Ireland in June while A Guide to the Deer of the World is due in July from Quiller Publishing.

For entomologists, this month's selection spans the globe. NatureBureau will publish <u>Butterflies of Kent & South East London</u> in May while we just received stock of <u>Butterflies of Botswana and Their Natural History</u> from the Lepidopterists' Society of Africa. The Association Vahatra has just published the bilingual English/French field guide <u>Dragonflies and Damselflies of Madagascar and the Western Indian Ocean Islands</u> and we are expecting stock of the Swedish guide to water beetles, <u>Vattenskalbaggar på Öland och i Sydöstra Småland</u>, published by Bildningsförlaget. On the topic of other invertebrates, we have a new fold-out guide from the Field Studies Council, Jellyfish and Allies of the British and Irish Coast, and three new books from ConchBooks: <u>Fossil and Recent Muricidae of the World</u>, Part Muricopsinae, The Conchological Albums – Terrestrial Molluscs, Volume 7: Camaenidae (3), and The Conchological Albums – Terrestrial Molluscs, Volume 8: Camaenidae (4).

For botanists, we have a range of different books. Falcon Guides will publish Wildflowers of North America: A Coast-to-Coast Guide to More than 500 Flowering Plants in May and we have just received stock of the privately published A Supplement to The Liverwort Flora of the British Isles. Leisurely reading is provided by Oliver Rackham's The Woods of South East Wales, due in July from Little Toller Books, and the paperback of Slime: A Natural History, due October from Granta. Meanwhile, mycologists can look out for Geoffrey Kibby's new book The Genus Cortinarius in Britain, which is due this month.

Finally, we have a selection of titles on different topics. Conservation biologists will want to take a look at <u>Effective Conservation: Parks, Rewilding, and Local Development</u>, due May from Island Press, and the second edition of <u>Extinction: A Radical History</u>, due June from OR Books. Readers of environmental history will be interested in <u>Fen, Bog & Swamp: A Short History of Peatland Destruction and Its Role in the Climate Crisis</u>, due September from Fourth Estate, while on the topic of evolutionary biology we recommend <u>Ancestors in Evolutionary Biology: Linear Thinking about Branching Trees</u>, due July from Cambridge University Press. Interesting science history comes in the form of <u>All the Land</u> from Seagull Books. Those looking to travel to Africa will want to

consider Stuarts' Field Guide to National Parks & Game Reserves: Namibia, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Zambia, Malawi, due May from Penguin Random House South Africa, while more regional natural history is provided by The Nature of Cambridge, due May from NatureBureau, and South Devon Wildlife Walks: Kingsbridge Area, which was just published by the author.

As always, if you are looking for a particular title that we do not yet have in our range, or you would like to suggest a title for NHBS to stock, please do get in touch. In the meantime, stay safe and keep well.
