Welcome to the May 2019 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We are leading with botany and mycology this month as we have two outstanding titles to announce. Princeton University Press will publish the massive two-volume set <u>Fungi of Temperate Europe</u> in October, authored by none less than Thomas Læssøe and Jens H. Petersen. A much more general mycology title form Princeton, due the same month, is <u>Fungipedia: A Brief Compendium of Mushroom Lore</u>. The other big book to mention here is Kew's <u>Field Guide to the Wild Elevers of the Eastern Mediterranean</u> also due October. This complements the guide to the western Mediterranean which was published in 2016.

A similarly exciting announcement can be made for invertebrates this month, as we have news regarding two much-expected butterfly titles. NAP Editions in France has just published <u>Moths of Europe</u>, <u>Volume 5: Noctuids 1</u> and <u>Moths of Europe</u>, <u>Volume 6: Noctuids 2</u>, while Brill will publish the two-volume set The Geometrid Moths of Europe, <u>Volume 6: Ennominae II</u>, which concludes this series. Falcon Guides has just released

Insects of North America: A Field Guide to Over 300 Insects, while NatureBureau will publish A Beginner's Guide to Dragonflies & Damselflies of Britain & Ireland in August.

For the vertebrates we have a small number of titles this month. Atlantic Books will publish the paperback of <u>Sloths! A Celebration of the World's Most Maligned Mammal</u> in October. Birdwatchers will be pleased to see two new Dave Gosney guides, <u>Finding Birds in Mid France</u> and <u>Finding Birds in Catalonia</u>, while Harper Collins will publish <u>Bird Photographer of the Year</u>, Collection 4 in August.

On the topics of wildlife conservation and environmental issues we have two titles. Johns Hopkins is adding yet another title to their Wildlife Management and Conservation series in September with <u>Quantitative Analyses in Wildlife Science</u>. Polity Press is publishing <u>Who Should Own Natural Resources</u>? in their Political Theory Today series in June.

For evolutionary biologists, we have two interesting titles. Edward O. Wilsons latest book, published by Allen Lane, is <u>Genesis: The Deep Origin of Societies</u>, which forms bridges between his writings on human evolution and social insects. We also have stock of a <u>Lost World: Secrets of a World Heritage Site</u> from The Gibraltar Museum, which is a photographic book showcasing all the species whose remains have been found alongside those of Neanderthals in the Gorham's Cave Complex. More general popular science comes in the form of two paperback reissues, <u>Gene Machine: The Race to Decipher the Secrets of the Ribosome</u> from Oneworld Publications, and The Skeptics' Guide to the Universe: How To Know What's Really Real in a World Increasingly Full of Fake from Hodder & Stoughton.

Finally, three notable nature writing titles are Peter Wohlleben's new book <u>Walks in the Wild: A Guide through the Forest</u>, due July from Rider Books, John Lewis-Stempel's The Private Life of the Hare, due October from Doubleday, and Richard Jefferies: A Miscellany, due July from Galileo Publishers.
