Welcome to the May 2020 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month. With the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic those of us still working on-site have had to fill in other jobs part-time to keep the warehouse running, so this month's list is shorter than normal.

Starting with vertebrates, come October, Harper Collins will publish the paperback of [The Hidden World of the Fox](#), while Lynx has announced a large number of noteworthy titles. There are four new field guides: [Mammals of China](#) and [Mammals of South Asia](#) are coming in June, with [Birds of the Philippines](#) and [Birds of Malaysia](#) coming in July. That month they have also planned a more technical book with [The Largest Avian Radiation: The Evolution of Perching Birds, or the Order Passeriformes](#). Bloomsbury has announced the second edition of [Birds of East Africa](#) for October, while Johns Hopkins University Press has announced a very large book with the 850+-page [Lizards of the World: Natural History and Taxon Accounts](#), due October.

On the subject of invertebrates there are two butterfly books to mention. We are awaiting stock of [A Guide to the Butterflies of the Serra dos Orgaos: South-Eastern Brazil](#) while New Holland has recently published [Field Guide to Butterflies of Australia](#).

For botanists there are three titles to highlight. We recently received stock of [Discovering Isles of Scilly Wild Flowers](#) while a new BSBI Handbook, [Hawkweeds of South-East England](#), has just been published. Picador has announced an interesting history book with [Palace of Palms: Tropical Dreams and the Making of Kew](#), due July.

Finally, Routledge has just published [Leaving Space for Nature: The Critical Role of Area-Based Conservation](#) while the London NHM will publish [Wildlife Photographer of the Year, Portfolio 30](#) in October.
