### June 2019 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the June 2019 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

This month we lead with an exceptionally strong list of forthcoming bird titles. Princeton University Press will publish Oceanic Birds of the World: A Photo Guide in November, while Lynx is publishing a further three field guides in their Lynx and BirdLife International Field Guides series, Birds of the West Indies, due June, and Birds of Japan and Birds of Cambodia, both due in July. CSIRO will publish the third edition of Birds of Prey of Australia: A Field Guide in July, while John Beaufoy is publishing the second edition of A Photographic Field Guide to the Birds of Sri Lanka in September, as well as two site guides,

The 50 Best Birdwatching Sites In New Zealand, due August, and 125 Best Bird Watching Sites in India, due November. Of more national interest will be Bloomsbury's RSPB Garden Birds, due November, and Where to Watch Birds in Berkshire: 20 of the Best Sites, published by the Birds of Berkshire Atlas Group, which is in stock now. Lastly, we have three more art-oriented titles with Hummingbirds, Volume 1: North America, Central America & Caribbean from the Gorgas Science Foundation, which is in stock now, a paperback reprint of The Norfolk Cranes' Story, and the forthcoming bilingual book Turn the Tide: Birds around the North Sea, due in October from KNNV.

For other animal groups we have a couple of titles each worth mentioning. Cambridge University Press will publish

Studying Primates: How to Design, Conduct and Report Primatological Research in October, while Bloomsbury will publish Handbook of Whales, Dolphins and Porpoises in November. Njoka Books has just published

Venomous Snakes of Malawi: An Identification Guide to the 20 Species of Snake Considered Venomous to Humans in Malawi, which is in stock now, while John Beaufoy has announced A Naturalist's Guide to the Snakes of Australia for October. For entomologists Random House Struik will publish the second edition of A Guide to the Dragonflies & Damselflies of South Africa in August, while NatureBureau has announced a very exciting title for October:

Life Cycles of British & Irish Butterflies. It has been almost a century since this was last attempted.

For botanists there are three titles to look out for. Natural History Publications Borneo has jus released <u>A Field Guide to Aquatic Plants of Myanmar</u> and <u>A Guide to Wild Fruits of Borneo</u>, while the FSC has released a new fold-out guide titled <u>Guide to the Non-Native Invasive Plants of Britain and Ireland</u>. For mycologists there is Puffballs of Northern and Central Europe from the Swedish Mycological Society.

We have an exceptionally strong line up of conservation biology titles from Oxford University Press to announce. They will be publishing Conservation Drones: Mapping and Monitoring Biodiversity (paperback, June), An Introduction to Conservation Biology (2nd edition, July, on their Sinauer imprint), Population Dynamics for Conservation and Sampling Theory: For the Ecological and Natural Resource Sciences (both September), and A Practical Guide for Genetic Management of Fragmented Animal and Plant Populations in October. Association Vahatra has just published the large bilingual 3-volume set The Terrestrial Protected Areas of Madagascar: Their History, Description, and Biota. On the related topic of environmental issues we have This Is Not A Drill: The Extinction Rebellion Handbook, due June from Penguin Books, the paperback of 21 Lessons for the 21st Century, due August from Vintage, and Trees and Global Warming: The Role of Forests in Cooling and Warming the Atmosphere, due October from Cambridge University Press.

To round off this month's list, we have a miscellany of titles. On the subject of evolution and palaeontology there is

On the Backs of Tortoises: Darwin, the Galápagos, and the Fate of an Evolutionary Eden, due November from Yale University Press, and Trilobites, Dinosaurs and Mammoths: An Introduction to the Prehistory of the British Isles, a small book from the Palaeontological Association, available now. There is popular science in the form of paperback editions of

Never Home Alone: From Microbes to Millipedes, Camel Crickets, and Honeybees, the Natural History of Where We Live, due October from Basic Books, and Seeds of Science: Why We Got It So Wrong on GMOs, due October from Bloomsbury. Comstock will publish a general field guide with The Natural History of The Bahamas: A Field Guide, due October. Readers interested in wildlife photography and documentaries can look forward to Wildlife Photographer of the Year, Portfolio 29, due October from the London Natural History Museum, and BBC Wildlife Documentaries in the Age of Attenborough, due November from Palgrave. Armchair reading this month comes in the form of Reef Life: An Underwater Memoir, due November from Profile Books, and The Fens: Discovering England's Ancient Depths, due July from Head of Zeus.
