## July 2019 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the July 2019 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a number of several high-profile titles for the different vertebrate taxa to announce. Bloomsbury will publish a new Helm Identification Guide in December with Birds of Paradise and Bowerbirds which has been in the making (and recorded in our database) for some two decades. On the subject of mammals we have Polar Bears & Humans, authored and published by photographer, author, expedition leader, and conservationist Ode J. Liodden which is a richly illustrated, large-format book on polar bears and the threat they face from hunting. Then there are two exciting fish titles. Johns Hopkins University Press will publish <u>Tunas and Billfishes of the World</u> in October, while the Ray Society will publish a facsimile of the classic work Hamilton's Gangetic Fishes in Colour: A New Edition of the 1822 Monograph, with Reproductions of Unpublished Coloured Illustrations in August.

For entomologists we have several excellent field guides lined up. Naturebureau will publish the second edition of <u>A Comprehensive Guide to Insects of Britain & Ireland</u> in November, while WILDGuides will publish the second edition of <u>Britain's Day-Flying Moths: A Field Guide to the Day-Flying Moths of Britain and Ireland</u> in September. Nature Books India has just published <u>Geometrid Moths of India</u>, while KNNV has announced a Dutch book on moths, <u>Het Nachtvlinderboek</u>, for September. For arachnid-lovers, the paperback of <u>Common Spiders of North America</u> is due December from the University of California Press.

Botanists and mycologists have a number of field guides to look forward to. Random House Struik will publish <u>Field Guide to Mushrooms & Other Fungi in South Africa</u> and KNNV will publish a basic field guide to mushrooms in Dutch with <u>Basisgids Paddenstoelen</u>, both due August. Another Dutch title worth mentioning is a basic guide to ornamental exotic plants: <u>Basisgids Stinzenplanten</u>, due December. Then there are two books from SANBI in South Africa that we will be stocking: Plants of the Free State: Inventory and Identification Guide and A Taxonomic Revision of Calobota (Fabaceae, Crotalarieae).

Moving on to evolutionary biology and ecology, Johns Hopkins University Press is publishing <u>The Rise of Reptiles</u>: 320 Million Years of Evolution in October, part of their (unofficial) Rise of... series, while Allen Lane has announced <u>The Case Against Reality</u>: <u>How Evolution Hid the Truth from Our Eyes</u> for August. The University of Chicago Press will publish <u>Phylogenetic Ecology</u>: <u>A History</u>, <u>Critique & Remodeling</u> in November, which promises to be a foundational text explaining why the study of evolutionary relatedness is important to both ecology and conservation biology.

On the subject of conservation and the environment, Little Toller Book will publish Living with Trees: A Common Ground Handbook in August. Also due that month is the paperback of <u>The World in a Grain: The Story of Sand and How It Transformed Civilization</u> from Riverhead Books, which is a gripping reportage on an unlikely resource crisis. A more historical perspective on climate change is offered in an updated edition of <u>The Little Ice Age: How Climate Made History, 1300-1850</u>, due December, written by famed archaeologist Brian Fagan.

We round out this month's selection with two miscellaneous September titles. KNNV will publish a fourth printing of the second edition of <u>Crossbill Guide: Extremadura, Spain</u>, which has been expanded with new routes. For those wishing to stay indoors, there is <u>Wintering: A Season with Geese</u> from Elliott & Thompson. This will be the second book from Stephen Rutt who positively surprised us recently with is debut The Seafarers: A Journey Among Birds.
