Welcome to the July 2020 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have some excellent mammal titles for you this time. Lynx has announced [Illustrated Checklist of the Mammals of the World](#) for September. This large, 2-volume set follows on from the completion of the [Handbook of the Mammals of the World](#) series and, as Lynx did for their birds series, it offers an overview of the current taxonomy and distribution of all of the world's mammal species. Cambridge University Press will publish [Bears of the World: Ecology, Conservation and Management](#) in November, which is the third title in this format to which Mario Melletti has contributed. Princeton University Press has announced [Felids and Hyenas of the World: Wild Cats, Panthers, Lynx, Pumas, Ocelots, Caracals, and Relatives](#) for December which is the third Princeton Field Guide authored by José R Castelló. The University of Chicago Press will publish the large 752-page [Chimpanzees in Context: A Comparative Perspective on Chimpanzee Behavior, Cognition, Conservation, and Welfare](#) in November. Johns Hopkins University Press, then, will publish [Semi-Aquatic Mammals: Ecology and Biology](#) in December, which covers common species such as beavers and hippos, but also other less well-known species.

On the subject of birds, we have several titles for birdwatchers both amateur and professional. Harper Collins has announced [Bird Photographer of the Year, Collection 5](#) for August and [The Collins Garden Birdwatcher's Bible](#) for October, while Princeton University Press will publish the richly illustrated [What Is a Bird?: An Exploration of Anatomy, Physiology, Behavior, and Ecology](#) in November. The team over at The Sound Approach has just published [Morocco: Sharing The Birds: A Sound Approach Guide to Birds of the Maghreb](#) which this time around comes with USB key of sound recordings rather than audio CDs. Edizioni Belvedere has just published [The Birds of Italy, Volume 2: Pteroclididae - Locustellidae](#), which is in stock now. The New South Wales Bird Atlassers, meanwhile, have recently published the [An Atlas of the Birds of NSW & the ACT, Volume 3](#), which is the last part of this three-volume work detailing the distribution of birds in the Australian regions of New South Wales and the Australian Capital Territory.

We have three herpetology titles, two of which are published by Chimaira: [Incubating Chelonian Eggs](#) has just been published and is in stock, while [Leaf-Tailed Geckos – The Complete Uroplatus](#) will come in September. Oxford University Press has announced [Anaconda: The Secret Life of the World's Largest Snake](#) for October, which will be authored by anaconda expert Jesús Antonio Rivas.

On the topics of insects and other invertebrates we have [Super Fly: The Unexpected Lives of the World's Most Successful Insects](#) by ethologist Jonathan Balcombe, due November from Plume Books. ConchBooks has just published two books, one of general interest, [A Guide to Marine Molluscs of Europe](#), and rather specialist, [The Fissurellidae from the Philippines with the Description of 26 New Species](#). Lastly, the Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle in Paris will publish [Tropical Deep-Sea Benthos, Volume 31: Deep-Sea Crustaceans from Papua New Guinea](#) in July.

For botanists, we have stock of the brand new [A Flora of Cornwall](#), published by the author, which is the first such flora in two decades. William Collins has announced [Planting the World: Joseph Banks and his Collectors: An Adventurous History of Botany](#) in August, while Safe Haven Books will publish [London Tree Walks: 30 Guided Walks Around the Green Metropolis](#) in September. For mycologists, there is the third edition of [Mushrooms and Toadstools of Britain & Europe, Volume 1](#) from Geoffrey Kibby, which features minor changes compared to the second edition. Another rerelease is the second edition of [The Myxomycetes of Britain and Ireland: An Identification Handbook](#) from Richmond Publishing. Brand new is [Polypores of the Mediterranean Region](#), which has just been published by Romar.

On the topic of environmental issues, Sir David Attenborough is writing [A Life on Our Planet: My Witness Statement and Vision for the Future](#), which will be published in October by Ebury Press. Dieter Helm is working on [Net Zero: How We Stop Causing Climate Change](#), due September from Harper Collins. We also have stock of [Notes from an Apocalypse: A Personal Journey to the End of the World and Back](#) which has just been published by Granta Books.

For ecologists, we have [Foundations for Advancing Animal Ecology](#), due December from Johns Hopkins University Press, and the paperback of [Serendipity: An Ecologist's Quest to Understand Nature](#), due November from the University of California Press. KNNV has published the 5th edition of their Dutch marine identification guide [Zeeboek: Determinatietabellen voor Flora en Fauna van de Nederlandse Kust](#).

Finally, two general titles are the paperback of [The Lost Species: Great Expeditions in the Collections of Natural History Museums](#), due November from the University of Chicago Press, and [COVID-19: The Pandemic that Never Should Have Happened, and How to Stop the Next One](#), due July from Little, Brown and Company.
