Welcome to the July 2021 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a variety of titles on animals this month. Two interesting birds books are coming in December with Christopher Helm publishing Vagrancy in Birds and the National Geographic Society releasing the third edition of National Geographic Complete Birds of North America. Edition Chimaira is publishing Field Guide to the Amphibians and Reptiles of Israel this month, while the Field Studies Council has just released a new AIDGAP guide, Freshwater Snails of Britain and Ireland. Available now is the fourth edition Coral Finder: Indo-Pacific from BYOGuides.

We have two notable botanical field guides. Filbert Press will publish A Field Guide to the Plants of Armenia in October while the Field Studies Council has just published Sphagnum Mosses: Field Key to the Mosses of Britain and Ireland. Meanwhile, Princeton University Press has announced The Lives of Seaweeds: A Natural History of Our Planet's Seaweeds & Other Algae for December and Windgather Press will publish The Tree Experts: A History of Professional Arboriculture in Britain this month.

On the topic of wildlife conservation and environmental issues, there are a number of noteworthy books. Two books that were published recently are

The Illegal Wildlife Trade in China: Understanding The Distribution Networks from Palgrave and

Endangered Ecosystems: Rights of Nature Protection for the Benefit of Both Ecosystems and Individual Species from the Green Economics Institute. Bloomsbury has announced a collection of literary essays, <u>Abundance: Nature in Recovery</u>, for September. Two books have just been published on the history of environmental thought <u>Environmental Thought: A Short History</u> from Polity Press and <u>The Environment: A History of an Idea</u> from Johns Hopkins University Press. Oxford University Press has just published <u>Phosphorus: Past and Future</u>, which is one of the few general books on this topic. We would also like to draw your attention to <u>Green Ideas</u> from Penguin, a series of 20 short books with classic writings from some of the most visionary environmental thinkers and activists of the last 75 years.

Finally, a smattering of titles that should make for fine reading. This includes three environmental history titles,

The Longest Story: How Humans Have Loved, Hated and Misunderstood Other Species from Oneworld Publications, Ice Ages: Their Social and Natural History due October from Cambridge University Press, and <u>Oil Palm: A Global History</u> which has just been published by the University of North Carolina Press. Little Toller is reissuing Richard Mabey's <u>Nature Cure</u> in a nice hardback format this month, while Brian Jackman's autobiography <u>West with the Light: My Life in Nature</u> will be published in August by Bradt. Richard Dawkins is working on <u>Flights of Fancy: Defying Gravity by Design and Evolution</u>, due November from Apollo, while Lee McIntyre is writing How to Talk to a Science Denier: Conversations with Flat Earthers, Climate Deniers, and Others Who Defy Reason, due August from MIT Press.
