Welcome to the September 2018 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month. You might have noticed that the subject classification differs a bit from previous catalogues. We are currently in the process of revamping our subject classification tree in an effort to highlight our best-selling subjects more. More subtle changes will be introduced in the months ahead. If you do have any questions, or cannot find certain subjects, do please let us know.

We have a number of excellent books lined up for birdwatchers and ornithologists. Bloomsbury will publish <u>Birds of Spain</u> in February and a second edition of <u>Birds of Japan and North-East Asia: A Photographic Guide</u> in January. Harper Collins will publish <u>The Wall of Birds: One Planet, 243 Families, 375 Million Years</u> in December, which looks set to be a beautiful combination of field guide and science illustration. John Beaufoy will publish a second edition of <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Sri Lanka</u> in October and <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Myanmar</u> in February. Finally, Snowfinch Publishing will release soon Steller's Sea Eagle and we expect to have stock at the end of the month.

There are two books on mammals worth mentioning; Pelagic Publishing will release <u>Muntjac and Water Deer: Natural History, Environmental Impact and Management in</u> January, and Natural History Publications Borneo has just published the second edition of <u>Orang-Utan: The Natural History of an Endangered Ape</u>. On the subject of reptiles – John Beaufoy will publish <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Lizards of Southeast Asia</u> in February.

Customers interested in insects and other invertebrates will want to take a look at <u>The Grasshoppers of Greece</u>, which was just published by the European Invertebrate Survey in the Netherlands and <u>Pacific Northwest Insects</u>, published by the Seattle Audubon Society. Closer to home, the Hertfordshire Natural History Society just published <u>Beetles of Hertfordshire</u>. ConchBooks, meanwhile, just published <u>Conidae from French Polynesia</u> and a new Visaya Supplement, New Species of Cerithiopsidae (Gastropoda: Triphoroidea) from Papua New Guinea (Pacific Ocean).

For botanists, we have two field guides worth highlighting: there is the privately published <u>Anglesey Flowering Plants and their Habitats</u>, and The Flora and Fauna of the Pacific Northwest Coast from the University of Washington Press.

For conservation biologists we have three very diverse titles coming up. Pelagic Publishing will release <u>Rebirding: Rewilding Britain and its Birds</u> in February, which promises to be a bold roadmap to reversing the decline of bird populations in Britain. Aurum Press has just published
<u>Mrs Pankhurst's Purple Feather: Fashion, Fury and Feminism – Women's Fight for Change</u>, which is a social history of how the suffragette movement gave to not just women's right to vote, but also the RSPB. Finally, Lopinga Books has just published <u>Island of Wildlife: The Story of Fingringhoe Wick - a Gravel Pit Nature Reserve</u>, which is an example of a local conservation success story, in this case centered on Essex.

Readers interested in evolution or ecology can look forward to four excellent books. Quercus Publishing will release the paperback of Darwin Comes to Town: How the Urban Jungle Drives Evolution in January, while Oxford University Press will release Clive Finlayson's book The Smart Neanderthal: Cave Art, Bird Catching, and the Cognitive Revolution in February. Pelagic Publishing will release a memoir by the famed carnivore expert Hans Kruuk in February, titled The Nature of Carnivores: Life and Travels with a Field Biologist and Bloomsbury will publish volume 7 of their British Wildlife Collection called Rocky Shores in February. Lastly, Princeton University Press has announced the academic monograph Time in Ecology: A Theoretical Framework for February.

Finally, in the category good reads we can recommend John Lewis-Stempel's book <u>The Wood: The Life & Times of Cockshutt Wood</u>, which will be published in paperback in February by Black Swan, Simon Barnes's book <u>Rewild Yourself: 23 Spells for Making Hidden Things Visible</u>, published by Simon & Schuster in November, and the large but excellent book <u>The Wizard and the Prophet: Two Remarkable Scientists and Their Conflicting Visions of the Future of Our Planet</u>, which will be published in paperback in January by Picador.
