September 2019 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the September 2019 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open this month with an exciting ornithology title: the second edition of Moult and Ageing in European Passerines, which will be published by Christopher Helm in February 2020. The first edition was incredibly popular and highly sought-after once it went out of print, so this revision is most welcome. Then there are two new guides for African birds: the Royal Museum for Central Africa has just published The Birds of Cameroon: Their Status and Distribution, which is in stock now, and Tauraco Press will publish The Birds of Benin and Togo: An Atlas and Handbook by the end of the year. John Beaufoy has announced the Field Guide to the Birds of Malaysia & Singapore for February. Closer to home is The Birds of Holland Park And Their Precious Habitats, published by the London-based charity The Friends of Holland Park. There is also one monograph to announce for February: Barn Owls: Evolution and Ecology – with Grass Owls, Masked Owls and Sooty Owls will be published by Cambridge University Press.

For herpetologists, too, there are some excellent new titles in the pipeline. Edition Chimaira has announced a new batch of books, all of which are due to be published this month. There are a fauna, Amphibians and Reptiles of Morocco, and two monographs,

The African and Middle Eastern Burrowing Asps (Atractaspis spp.) and Their Allies: Biology, Venom and Envenoming and

The Gila Monster: Heloderma suspectum: Natural History, Husbandry & Propagation. The South African National Biodiversity Institute has published

A Bilingual Field Guide to the Frogs of Zululand, written in English and Zulu. Lastly, we have just received stock for the ebook

RepFocus: A Survey of the Reptiles of the World which is delivered on a USB drive. This work is a massive compilation of information with over 4000 distribution maps, over 1000 regional checklists and a bibliography of nearly 110,000 references.

On the subject of invertebrates we have two titles this month. Bloomsbury will publish the second edition of Concise Guide to the Moths of Great Britain and Ireland in November, featuring illustrations by Richard Lewington. The lvy Press will publish Spiders: A Diverse Natural History in February, which is edited by Norman I. Platnick, the curator emeritus of spiders at the American Museum of Natural History.

For botanists we have received stock of a landmark publication, the 3-volume set

Plant Galls of Europe: Keys to Plant Galls (Zoo- and Phytocecidia) of Central- and Northern Europe, published by KNNV in the Netherlands. Based on seminal work by earlier authors, this work describes over 10,000 galls and malformations in over 2200 pages. Head of Zeus will publish Flowers of the Field: Meadow, Moor and Woodland in October, which is a visually stunning survey of Britain's best-loved wildflowers with a focus on the three mentioned habitats. And lastly, we just received stock of Plant Identification for Phase 1 Habitat Survey: Heaths and Meres, which is the second such fold-out guide published by the Field Studies Council.

For readers interested in wildlife conservation and environmental issues we have a new addition to the series Amphibian Biology. After the demise of the Australian publisher Surrey Beatty & Sons, the responsibility for the still-to-be-published parts was scattered around the globe and we just tracked down Amphibian Biology, Volume 9, Part 4: Status of Decline of Amphibians: Western Hemisphere: Peru and Bolivia, which was published in an issue of Herpetological Monographs by The Herpetologists' League. Cambridge University Press has announced two new volumes in their Ecology, Biodiversity and Conservation series: Ecological-Economic Modelling for Biodiversity Conservation and Curious about Nature: A Passion for Fieldwork, both due in February. Oxford University Press will publish Disaster by Choice: How Our Actions Turn Natural Hazards into Catastrophes, due February, which promises to be a provocative book arguing that so-called natural disasters really lie in our inability to deal with the environment and with ourselves.

For evolutionary biologists there are two hefty academic tomes in the making. Oxford University Press will publish Brains Through Time: A Natural History of Vertebrates in December, while Princeton University Press will publish The Invertebrate Tree of Life in March. Lighter reading is provided by the paperback of E.O. Wilson's Genesis: On the Deep Origin of Societies, which is due in February from Penguin Books.

Finally, on the subject of general natural history we can announce <u>The Rules of the Flock: Self-Organization and Swarm Structure in Animal Societies</u>, due February from Oxford University Press, and <u>The Pelagic Dictionary of Natural History of the British Isles: Descriptions of all Species with a Common Name</u>, due January from Pelagic Publishing.
