## September 2020 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the September 2020 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have some great bird titles this month. A noteworthy last-minute drop-in is the bilingual (English and Chinese) Ageing & Sexing of Migratory East Asian Passerines from Avium Förlag. The Mammal Society just published the 5th edition of The Analysis of Owl Pellets, while the Lancashire & Cheshire Fauna Society released Lancashire Bird Report 2019, the most recent in this annual series. We now also stock

Urban Lady: The Phenomenon of the Long-Eared Owl Wintering Grounds in the Cities of Northern Bosnia and Herzegovina, which is privately published. Lastly, two Dutch titles from KNNV are De Zeearend in Nederland: In 15 Jaar naar 15 Paar [The White-Tailed Eagle in the Netherlands: 15 Pairs in 15 Years] which was released in February, and Vogels en hun Veren: Verenkleed, Rui en Ruipatronen per Soortgroep [Understanding Bird Moult: A Guide for the Field Ornithologist] which is due this month

Other fauna titles this month cover mammals and insects. Meru Publishing will release

Mammals of Ethiopia, Eritrea, Djibouti and Somalia: Field Guide to the Larger Mammals of the Horn of Africa in October, while Brill has announced the second edition of Catalogue of Palaearctic Coleoptera, Volume 5: Tenebrionoidea, which is due this month.

Readers interested in botany and mycology will want to take a look at the Dutch field guide <u>Basisgids Bomen en Struiken</u> [Basic Guide to Trees and Shrubs], recently published by KNNV, and the third edition of <u>Where the Slime Mould Creeps</u>, recently published by Tympanocryptis Press.

Conservation biology is represented this month by the recently published Parrot Conservation: From Kakapo to Lear's Macaw: Tales of Hope From Around the World from New Holland and the third edition of The Bat House Builder's Handbook from University of Texas Press, which is due this month. Readers interested in environmental issues can look forward to the paperback of Naomi Klein's On Fire: The Burning Case for a Green New Deal, due this month from Penguin Books, the paperback of Feeding Britain: Our Food Problems and How to Fix Them, due February from Pelican, and the second edition of There Is No Planet B: A Handbook for the Make or Break Years, due January from Cambridge University Press.

For ecologists, we have Habitat Ecology and Analysis from Oxford University Press and Pollinators & Pollination: Nature and Society from Pelagic Publishing, both of which will be published in January. Palaeontologists can look out for Fossil Spiders in Baltic Amber: An Annotated Systematic Catalogue, due November from Siri Scientific Press.

Finally, for those who want to stay indoors there is the second edition of <u>Viruses</u>, <u>Plagues</u>, <u>and History</u>: <u>Past</u>, <u>Present</u>, <u>and Future</u>, due October from Oxford University Press, while those who wish to venture outside will want to read the paperback of <u>Losing Eden</u>: <u>Why Our Minds Need the Wild</u> from Penguin Books or Wild Woods: An Explorer's Guide to Britain's Woods and Forests from Bradt, both due in February.
