Welcome to the October 2018 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

Several exciting bird books came to our attention this month. The next New Naturalist (after The Burren) will be [Gulls](#), authored by John Coulson, and is due for publication in March from Harper Collins. As every year around October, we can announce the next [Birdwatcher's Yearbook](#), the 2019 edition being due this month from Calluna Books. Springer will publish [Lesser Flamingos: Descendants of Phoenix](#) in January. Brill will publish a second edition of [Field Guide to the Birds of Suriname](#) in November. Bloomsbury will publish the [RSPB Guide to Birdsong](#) March next year, which will include an audio CD. Lastly, Houghton Mifflin will publish [Peterson Reference Guide to Sparrows of North America](#) in March.

For herpetologists there are two titles in particular worth highlighting. Auckland University Press will publish [Reptiles and Amphibians of New Zealand: A Field Guide](#) in November, while Chimaira has just published the long-awaited next installment in their Terralog series: [Venomous Snakes of South America](#).

Entomologists and those interested in other invertebrates have three books in particular to look forward to. Ivy Press will publish [Dragonflies & Damselflies: A Natural History](#) in March. The Field Studies Council has just published [Synopsis of the British Fauna Volume 62: Marine Gastropods 3: Neogastropoda](#), which is the third and final installment to deal with marine gastropods. Of a lighter nature is [Octopuses](#), a new Ladybird Expert Book that is due March. It will be authored by none other than Helen Scales who has published some fantastic books on marine fauna in recent years.

For botanists we have two hard-to-find titles. From the University of Helsinki we have a new field guide, [Sphagnum Mosses: The Stars of European Mires](#) that is now in stock. We also expect stock for the second edition of [Where the Slime Mould Creeps](#) from Tasmania this month. Furthermore, CRC Press will publish a second edition of [Plankton: Guide to Their Ecology and Monitoring for Water Quality](#) in February.

On the topic of conservation and biodiversity there are a number of noteworthy titles. Academic Press will publish [Wildlife Conservation in Africa: A Scientific Approach](#) in March, while Cambridge University Press will publish [Infrastructure Development and Ape Conservation](#) in October. We have just received stock of [A Sustainable Future: 12 Key Areas of Global Concern](#) from Haus Publishing. The University of Chicago Press will publish [Abundant Earth: Toward an Ecological Civilization](#), authored by Eileen Crist, in December. Finally, economist Dieter Helm, who has authored books such as *Burn Out*, *Carbon Crunch* and *Natural Capital*, is writing [Green and Prosperous Land](#), due March from Harper Collins in which he puts forward a 25-year game plan to turn Britain into a green and prosperous land.

Readers interested in evolutionary biology or animal behaviour have two paperback to look out for. Edward O. Wilson's [The Origins of Creativity](#) will be published in paperback in November by Allen Lane, while the paperback of [Spying on Whales: The Past, Present and Future of the World's Largest Animals](#) is due in March from Harper Collins. Primatologist Frans de Waal's next book is called [Mama's Last Hug: Animal and Human Emotions](#) and is due for publication in March by Granta Books.

Three books of interest to ecologists are [Encyclopedia of Caves](#), which will be published in its 3rd edition in March by Academic Press, [Effects of Anthropogenic Noise on Animals](#) from Springer, available now, and [The Peatlands of Britain and Ireland: A Traveller's Guide](#), due March from Sandstone Press.

Museums and libraries will be pleased to see a paperback edition of [Life on Display: Revolutionizing US Museums of Science & Natural History in the Twentieth Century](#) due for publication in October from the University of Chicago Press.

Finally, for armchair readers, we have [All the Land](#), which is a biography of Alfred Wegener due December from Seagull Books, [The End of the End of the Earth](#) Jonathan Franzen due November from Fourth Estate, and a new coffee table book from Global Wildlife Conservation: [Islands](#), of which we expect stock this month.
