Welcome to the October 2020 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We start off this month with books on birds. This time of year brings not only autumn but also the next [Birdwatcher's Yearbook](#). Furthermore, we just received stock of Richard Sale's new book [The Common Kestrel](#). Christopher Helm has announced the third edition of their Helm Field Guide [Birds of Chile](#) for March, while John Beaufoy Publishing has just released the third edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Sri Lanka](#). We previously announced a new book from Giovanni Leonardi, which will now be published in December by Springer as [Behavioural Ecology of Western Palearctic Falcons](#). A new addition to Bloomsbury's RSPB Spotlight Series is [Crows](#), due March. And lastly, we have stock of the [Avon Bird Report 2019](#).

That is all for the vertebrates this month, so we move straight on to insects and other invertebrates. In March Johns Hopkins University Press will publish [Mosquitoes of the World](#), a must-have reference in two volumes. Princeton University Press has announced [Wasps: The Astonishing Diversity of a Misunderstood Insect](#) for the same month. From the Santa Barbara Museum of Natural History in California we have [Bivalve Seashells of Western South America: Marine Bivalve Mollusks from Punta Aguja, Perú to Isla Chiloé, Chile](#), while ConchBooks has just published three titles: [Cenozoic Non-Marine and Brackish Water Gastropods from Italy: Neritimorpha, Caenogastropoda, Heterobranchia – Systematic and Chronostratigraphic Revision](#); [The Genera Cyrellia, Leufroyia & Raphitoma Living in the French Mediterranean](#); and [Philippine Amphidromus: A Taxonomic and Nomenclatural Puzzle](#).

Two notable mycology titles, both due this month, are the second edition of [Grassland Fungi: A Field Guide](#), published by the Monmouthshire Meadows Group, and [The Secret Life of Fungi: Discoveries from a Hidden World](#), published by Elliott & Thompson.

On the topic of wildlife conservation and environmental issues we have [Beloved Beasts: Fighting for Life in an Age of Extinction](#) from W.W. Norton, and Naomi Klein's [How To Change Everything](#) from Penguin Books, which is an adaptation of her book This Changes Everything for younger readers. Both of these are due in March.

For ecologists, we have two practical titles from Pelagic Publishing: [Measuring Abundance: Methods for the Estimation of Population Size and Species Richness](#) has just been published, while [Writing Effective Ecological Reports: A Guide to Principles and Practice](#) is due in January.

Evolutionary biologists can look out for two new titles from big names. Dutton Books will publish Carl Zimmer's new book [Life's Edge: The Search for What It Means to Be Alive](#) in March, while Bloomsbury has recently published Rutger Bregman's [Humankind: A Hopeful History](#).

In the category of nature writing and other good reads we can announce the paperback of Tim Dee's [Greenery: Journeys in Springtime](#), due March from Vintage, and Wade Davis's [Magdalena: River of Dreams](#), which has just been published by Bodley Head. Continuing to be topical is Adam Kucharski's [The Rules of Contagion: Why Things Spread – and Why They Stop](#), due out in paperback in February from Profile Books. And last but by no means least is Bloomsbury's new addition to the British Wildlife Collection, due March. Clive Chatters is writing volume 9, which will be titled [Heathland](#).
