Welcome to the November 2021 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a large number of bird books this month. The British Ornithologists' Club has just published [The Birds of St Vincent, the Grenadines and Grenada: An Annotated Checklist](#), for which NHBS is the distributor. We similarly have stock for the [Lancashire Bird Report 2020](#) and the [Avon Bird Report 2020](#). Whittles Publishing has announced [The Corncrake: An Ecology of an Enigma](#) for March and we are expecting stock of [Birds of Malaysia in Watercolour: The Art of Choo Beng Teong](#) from Natural History Publications Borneo. Various paperback reissues are on the horizon: March will see [A Most Remarkable Creature: The Hidden Life and Epic Journey of the World's Smartest Bird of Prey](#) from Vintage, while April will see [A World on the Wing: The Global Odyssey of Migratory Birds](#) from Picador and [Swifts and Us: The Life of the Bird that Sleeps in the Sky](#) from HarperCollins.

For other vertebrate groups, we have a few titles this month. Springer has announced [Field Guide to the Primates of Indonesia](#) for November, while Bloomsbury is publishing [Field Guide to Whales, Dolphins and Porpoises](#) in April. Also due in April is the third edition of [Biology of Sharks and their Relatives](#) from CRC Press.

We have several excellent entomology titles this month. Natural History Publications Borneo has released [Vampire Moths: Behaviour, Ecology and Taxonomy of Blood-Sucking Calyptra](#), while KNNV Publishing has published [The Gall Midges of Europe](#). Looking ahead, NatureBureau will publish [Pollinators in Crisis: How We Can All Give Them a Helping Hand](#) in March. Two noteworthy paperback reissues are [Tales from the Ant World](#), just published by Liveright Publishing Corporation, and [Empire of Ants: The Hidden Worlds and Extraordinary Lives of Earth's Tiny Conquerors](#), due April from Gaia Books. For malacologists, there is a bumper crop of new titles from ConchBooks with [Compendium of Marine Gastropods](#), [A Guide to the Hunter Shells, Volume 1: The Streptaxoidea: The Gulellinae and Primagulellinae](#), and three new volumes in the ongoing series The Conchological Albums – Terrestrial Molluscs with [Volume 2: Achatinidae \(2\), Aciculidae, Agardhiellidae, Amastridae, Amphibulimidae, Argnidae, Volume 3: Annulariidae, Ariophantidae, Azecidae, Bothriembryontidae \(1\)](#), and [Volume 4: Bothriembryontidae \(2\), Bulimulidae \(1\)](#) now available.

For botanists, we have an extraordinary line-up. Redfern Natural History has just published the second edition of [A Compendium of Miniature Orchid Species](#) (now a 4-volume set), the BSBI is releasing the [Field Handbook to British and Irish Dandelions](#), which is a reworked second edition of Dandelions of Great Britain and Ireland, and Natural History Publications Borneo has released [Morning Glories of Thailand and Southeast Asia](#). Two notable books with a more narrative slant to them are [The Treeline: The Last Forest and the Future of Life on Earth](#), due January from Jonathan Cape, and the paperback of the excellent [Tree Story: The History of the World Written in Rings](#), due April from Johns Hopkins University Press.

On the subject of conservation and biodiversity, we have four books worth mentioning. Doubleday will publish [Wild Fell: Fighting for Nature on a Lake District Hill Farm](#) in February, HarperCollins is reissuing [Beak, Tooth and Claw: Living with Predators in Britain](#) in paperback in April, and Global Wildlife Conservation (formerly known as Conservation International) has published two new additions to their CEMEX Nature Series: [Nature's Solutions to Climate Change](#) and [Key Biodiversity Areas](#). Four other books tackle environmental issues. John Murray is releasing Rob Dunn's [A Natural History of the Future: What the Laws of Biology Tell Us About the Destiny of the Human Species](#) in January, Hodder & Stoughton has just published Amitav Ghosh's [The Nutmeg's Curse: Parables for a Planet in Crisis](#), Verso Books has announced [Ending Fossil Fuels: Why Net Zero is Not Enough](#) for November, while Penguin Books have bundled their Green Ideas series into [a 20-volume boxed set](#).

Finally, we have a smattering of titles on different topics. Palaeontology comes in the shape of [The Last Days of the Dinosaurs: An Asteroid, Extinction, and the Beginning of Our World](#), due April from St. Martin's Press. Animal behaviour is represented by the paperback reissue of Carl Safina's [Becoming Wild: How Animals Learn to be Animals](#), due April from Oneworld Publications. Two general field guides, [A Field Guide to British Rivers](#) from Wiley, and the second edition of [Field Guide to the Wildlife of New Zealand](#) from Bloomsbury Publishing, are due in November. To finish, we have regional natural history in March from NatureBureau with [The Nature of Somerset's Coast](#) and the paperback reissue of Peter Scott's biography [A Life in Nature](#) from Sphere Books in April.
