Welcome to the December 2021 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have several interesting bird books this month in different categories. There is one field guide, the second edition of

Field Guide to the Birds of the Dominican Republic and Haiti due May from Princeton University Press, and two popular works on a particular species group: Sally Coulthard's The Book of the Barn Owl, due March from Apollo, and the second edition of Penguins: The Ultimate Guide, due April from Princeton University Press. Two popular science titles on bird behaviour, both due in May, are <u>How Birds Live Together</u>: Colonies and Communities in the Avian World from Princeton University Press and the paperback of The Bird Way: A New Look at How Birds Talk, Work, Play, Parent, and Think from Corsair.

Turning to other vertebrate groups, there is one field guide to mammals in the pipeline:

Marine Mammals: A Guide to the Whales, Dolphins and Seals of Southern Africa and the Southern Ocean, due February from Struik Nature. We also have three noteworthy herpetology titles. Two are published by Edition Chimaira: <u>The Book of Monitor Lizards</u> is available now and <u>Herpetofauna Mexicana, Volume 2: Lizards of Mexico, Part 1: Iguanian Lizards is due January</u>. The third title, <u>Snakes and other Reptiles of Zambia and Malawi</u>, is due December from Struik Nature.

For entomologists and other invertebrate workers, we have some particularly exciting titles this month. NAP Editions will publish <u>Bumblebees of Europe</u> in December, which is the third title in their Hymenoptera of Europe series. We are also expecting stock of

Wasps – A Guide for Eastern North America: Their Biology, Diversity, and Role as Beneficial Insects and Pollinators of Native Plants from Pollination Press, and the Lancashire & Cheshire Fauna Society will publish Micro-Moth Field Tips, Volume 2: A Guide to Finding the Early Stages in Lancashire and Cheshire in December. For arachnologists, there is the Spiders of North America, due May from Princeton University Press.

For botanists, we similarly have some excellent titles to announce. The Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew will release Trees of New Guinea in April and Great Trees of Britain and Ireland: Over 70 of the Best Ancient Avenues, Forests and Trees to Visit in May, while Joseph Margraf Verlag has announced the third edition of Flora of the Azores for December. Other interesting books are Taming Fruit: How Orchards Have Transformed the Land, Offered Sanctuary, and Inspired Creativity from Greystone Books and available now, the paperback of The Journeys of Trees: A Story about Forests, People, and the Future, due April from W.W. Norton, and a new FSC fold-out guide, Guide to Woodlands: Trees, Flowers & Fungi, available now.

On the topic of conservation biology, readers can look out for the paperback of <u>Silent Earth: Averting the Insect Apocalypse</u>, due May from Vintage, and <u>Female Heroes of Bird Conservation</u>, published by the author Rosemary Low and available now. Regarding other environmental issues, there is <u>Half-Earth Socialism: A Plan to Save the Future from Extinction</u>, <u>Climate Change and Pandemics</u>, due April from Verso Books, George Monbiot's <u>Regenesis: How to Feed the World Without Devouring the Planet</u>, due May from Allen Lane, and the paperback of Sir David Attenborough's <u>A Life on Our Planet: My Witness Statement and a Vision for the Future</u>, due May from Ebury Press.

There are three very diverse books on evolution in the pipeline: The Paris Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle has just published <u>Nomad Lives: From Prehistoric Times to the Present Day</u>, and in May Profile Books will publish Frans de Waal's <u>Different: What Apes Can Teach Us About Gender</u> while Granta will publish Nick Lane's Transformer: The Deep Chemistry of Life and Death.

Finally, three miscellaneous titles, all of which are in stock. Editions Eugen Ulmer has just published the coffee-table book <u>Between Two Worlds: Under the Pole III: Four Years of Deep Diving for Scientific Exploration</u>, Riverside Woodcraft has released the pocket-sized <u>Animal Tracks Field Guide</u>, and there is one further new FSC fold-out guide, Coastal Wildlife of the North York Moors.
