

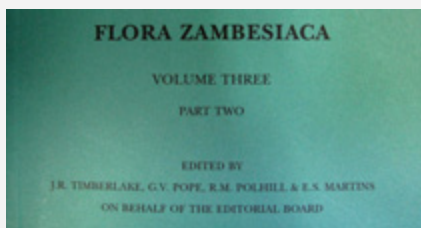
Standing Orders from NHBS

Placing a standing order means that NHBS will send each new volume in a monographic series as it is published. This service allows libraries to enjoy all the benefits of a standing order – we do the research, and let you know in advance as soon as we know the price of the next volume in any monographic series.

Invoicing Standing Orders

We bill you for each volume as we send it to you. In other words, the invoice will be created on the day of dispatch, or your credit card will be charged when the book is dispatched. If a pre-publication offer exists you will automatically receive it on the volume.

If you have a LibraryPro account, all normal benefits you receive will apply to standing orders, including volume discounts and a consolidated dispatch cycle.

How to arrange a Standing Order

If you would like to add a standing order to your NHBS account, please let us know the series title, which volume to start with, and your order reference, and we'll take care of the rest. All new volumes will be added as orders on your account as soon as we have all the necessary details of the publication, and we will send you an order acknowledgement in advance of invoicing you.
