February 2023 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the February 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open the month with a selection of titles on vertebrates. Mammals are represented by Urban Bats: Biology, Ecology, and Human Dimensions, just released by Springer. There are two new notable bird books, The Birds of Italy, Volume 3: Cisticolidae - Icteridae, just published by Edizioni Belvedere, and the second edition of Birds of Senegal and The Gambia, due July from Helm. Herpetologists can look out for the second edition of Frogs of the United States and Canada, due in August from Johns Hopkins University Press. In its first edition, this was published as a two-volume set, but it will now be published as a single mammoth volume. On the topic of fish, Wild Nature Press will publish Field Guide to Sharks, Rays & Chimaeras of the East Coast of North America in July, and will complement their earlier guide for Europe and the Mediterranean

There are three invertebrate titles worth highlighting. We have stock of <u>Ladybirds of Europe: Field Guide</u>, published by HabiProt in the Czech Republic. The Field Studies Council has just released <u>Atlas of the Centipedes of Britain and Ireland</u>, while ConchBooks continues The Conchological Albums – Terrestrial Molluscs with volume 12: Cerionidae, Charopidae, Chondrinidae, Chronidae.

Botanists have three new books to look out for. Sceptre will publish Tristan Gooley's How to Read a Tree: Clues & Patterns from Roots to Leaves in April while NatureBureau has announced The Flora of Sutton Park National Nature Reserve: A Botanical Jewel in the Urban Midlands for March. We have just received stock of the French book Antoine-Laurent de Jussieu (1748-1836): Fabrique d'une Science Botanique from the Paris Museum of Natural History. For mycologists, there is the fourth edition of Where the Slime Mould Creeps, published by Tympanocryptis Press in Tasmania.

There is a good list of conservation-related titles this month. CSIRO will publish Thylacine: The History, Ecology and Loss of the Tasmanian Tiger in March, while Association Vahatra in Madagascar has just released The Protected Areas of Lokobe, Ankarana, and Montagne d'Ambre in Northern Madagascar, which is the first in a new series of bilingual ecotourism guides. Then there are three paperback reissues: Future Sea: How to Rescue and Protect the World's Oceans from the University of Chicago Press, which was published recently; Cornerstones: Wild Forces That Can Change Our World, which is due in July from Bloomsbury; and The Lost Rainforests of Britain, which is due in May from HarperCollins.

Two exciting ecology titles that are on the horizon are <u>Carnivoran Ecology</u>: <u>The Evolution and Function of Communities</u>, due in May from Oxford University Press, and Principles of Soundscape Ecology: <u>Discovering Our Sonic World</u>, due in July from the University of Chicago Press.
