

February 2024 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the February 2024 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We start with some outstanding ornithology and birdwatching titles. Bloomsbury has announced two titles due in July: [Identifying Migratory Birds by Sound in Britain and Europe](#) on their Helm imprint and [Storm-Petrels](#) on their Poyser imprint. There are two French titles co-published by Biotope and the Paris Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle that are out now: [Guide des Oiseaux de Guyane: Manuel d'identification](#) [Guide to the Birds of Guyana: Identification Handbook] and [Oiseaux de Nouvelle-Calédonie: Grande Terre, Îles Loyautés et Archipels Éloignés](#) [Birds of New Caledonia: Grande Terre, Loyalty Islands and Remote Archipelagos]. Two other overseas titles due in March are [The East Atlantic Flyway of Coastal Birds: 50 Years of Exciting Moments in Nature Conservation and Research](#) from Lynx Edicions and the Dutch [Handboek Vogels van Nederland](#) [Handbook of Birds of the Netherlands] from KNNV. Two reissues are Mark Avery's [Remarkable Birds](#), due in April from Thames & Hudson, and the paperback of Jennifer Ackerman's [What an Owl Knows: The New Science of the World's Most Enigmatic Birds](#), due in July from Oneworld Publications.

For other animal groups, we have a few titles this month. The Paris Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle is publishing [the third volume of their Atlas des Mammifères Sauvages de France](#) [Atlas of Wild Mammals of France], focusing on carnivores and primates, in February. For herpetologists, we have [Proteus](#), a book on this rare cave salamander from Association Hyla in Hungary, and the second edition of [The Book of Snakes: A Lifesize Guide to Six Hundred Species from Around the World](#), due in March from The University of Chicago Press. On the subject of insects, NatureBureau has announced [The Moths of Lancashire](#), due in April.

For botanists, we have a range of titles. Two floras due in April are [Flora Zambesiaca, Volume 6, Part 5: Compositae](#) from Kew, and [World Atlas of Freshwater Macrophytes, Volume 1: Dicotyledonous Species I \(Acanthaceae - Menyanthaceae\)](#) from Springer. We have three field guides: John Beaufoy's [An Identification Guide to Trees of Britain and North-West Europe](#) is due in March, NatureBureau has just published [Flowering Plants & Ferns of Ascension Island](#), and the FSC has reprinted [British Water Plants](#). Lastly, Simon Barnes is turning his eyes toward botany in [How To Be a Bad Botanist](#), due in April from Simon & Schuster.

On the topic of conservation and other environmental issues readers can look forward to [Why Ecosystems Matter: Preserving the Key to Our Survival](#), due in July from Oxford University Press, and the paperback of [The Parrot and the Igloo: Climate and the Science of Denial](#), due June from W.W. Norton & Co. Two recently released titles are the paperback of [Endangered Species: A Reference Handbook](#) from Bloomsbury Academic, and the second edition of [Lost and Found: The History of Extermination, Discovery and Rediscovery of Mammals in Vietnam](#), privately published by Tilo Nadler.

Palaeontologists and evolutionary biologists can look out for [The Network of Life: A New View of Evolution](#), due in July from Princeton University Press; [Evolutionary Cell Biology: The Origins of Cellular Architecture](#), due in February from Oxford University Press; and the Dutch [Fascinerende Fossielen: Van Dinosaurius tot Reuzenalk: 50 Verdwenen Werelden](#) [Fascinating Fossils: From Dinosaurs to Great Auks: 50 Lost Worlds], due in February from KNNV. On the subject of ecology, Pelagic Publishing is releasing [QGIS for Ecologists: An Introduction to Mapping for Ecological Surveys](#) in June and [The Natural History of Blenheim's High Park](#) in July.

Finally, we have Rosemary Grant's memoir [One Step Sideways, Three Steps Forward: One Woman's Path to Becoming a Biologist](#), due in July from Princeton University Press and four Crossbill Guides. One of these is new, [Crossbill Guide: Tuscany, Italy](#), due in June; three of these are reprints with minor updates that are due in April: [Western Andalucía: Huelva to Málaga, Spain](#);
