Welcome to the March 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

On the subject of vertebrates, we bring you four noteworthy titles this month. Two herpetology titles are the Handbook of Amphibians and Reptiles of Northeast Africa, due in July from Bloomsbury, and the second edition of A Naturalist's Guide to the Frogs of Australia, due in May from John Beaufoy. We also have two books on sharks:

The Lives of Sharks: A Natural History of Shark Life is due in August from Princeton University Press and the paperback of Shark: Why We Need to Save the World's Most Misunderstood Predator is due in July from HarperCollins.

For invertebrates, we have a broad spread of titles. Entomologists can look out for Hymenoptera: The Natural History & Diversity of Wasps, Bees & Ants, due in May from Firefly Books. Straddling the border between insects and other invertebrates is the Naturalists' Handbooks Animals Under Logs and Stones, which will be published in July by Pelagic Publishing in a much-expanded second edition. Those interested in marine invertebrates are well served with the technical Tropical Deep-Sea Benthos, Volume 33: Deep-Sea Crustaceans from South-West Indian Ocean, just released by the Paris Museum of Natural History, and the more popular Many Things Under a Rock: The Mysteries of Octopuses, due in July from Hodder & Stoughton.

March brings a large number of conservation-themed titles. Some general titles are the introductory Biodiversity and Conservation: A Very Short Introduction, due in July from Oxford University Press; the popular Wildlings: How to Raise Your Family in Nature, due in paperback in April from Two Roads; and the academic The Living Planet: The State of the World's Wildlife, due in April from Cambridge University Press. Then there are a number of books geared towards specific groups of organisms: Yale University Press is publishing In the Herbarium: The Hidden World of Collecting and Preserving Plants in July, Cambridge University Press is publishing Gibbon Conservation in the Anthropocene in May, and Pelagic Publishing has announced Tadpole Hunter: A Personal History of Amphibian Conservation and Research for July and Finding W. H. Hudson: The Writer Who Came to Britain to Save the Birds for August. Lastly, a new ecotourism guide,

The Protected Areas of Mantadia and Analamazaotra in Central Eastern Madagascar, will be available this month from Association Vahatra, while the Paris Museum of Natural History has just published the French book Les îles Saint-Paul et Amsterdam (Océan Indien Sud): Environnement Marin et Pêcheries that gives a history of the

Two books dealing with environmental issues are the paperback of Regenesis: Feeding the World Without Devouring the Planet, due in May from Penguin Books, and the massive The Vortex: An Environmental History of the Modern World which clocks in at nearly 850 pages and is due in April from the University of Pittsburgh Press.

Then there are two notable palaeontology titles. Oxford University Press has just released Geological Pioneers of the Jurassic Coast while Johns Hopkins University Press has announced An Illustrated Guide to Dinosaur Feeding Biology for August.

Finally, there are five titles that fall under the rubric of good reads. HarperCollins has announced the paperback of <u>The Trials of Life: A Natural History of Animal Behaviour</u> for June, which is a reissue of David Attenborough's classic 1990 book. Ed Yong's popular science book

An Immense World: How Animal Senses Reveal the Hidden Realms Around Us is released in paperback in June by Vintage. Simon & Schuster has announced Simon Barnes's memoir The Year of Sitting Dangerously: My Garden Safari for April. And then there are two nature writing titles: Mark Cocker's One Midsummer's Day: Swifts and the Story of Life on Earth is due in June from Jonathan Cape and the paperback of Tom Blass's Swamp Songs: Journeys Through Marsh, Meadow and Other Wetlands is due in April from Bloomsbury.
