Welcome to the March 2025 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a large number of bird books this month. Three field guides to foreign destinations are <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Vietnam</u> from John Beaufoy Publishing, due in April; the updated second edition of <u>A Photographic Guide to the Birds of Indonesia</u> from Tuttle Publishing, due in June; and <u>Birds of Uruguay</u> from Bloomsbury, due in August. Pelagic Publishing has several excellent titles in the pipeline, with <u>The Physics of Birds & Birding: The Sounds, Colors and Movements of Birds, and Our Tools for Watching Them</u> due in May, followed in July by <u>The Merlin: The Ecology of a Magical Raptor</u> and <u>Crossbills & Conifers: One Million Years of Adaptation and Coevolution</u>. Two birdwatching-related titles now available are

The North Sea Bird Club 1979-2019: Birds, Bats and Beasties - Forty Years of Offshore Wildlife Recording, published by the North Sea Bird Club, and the third edition of Birdwatching in Northern Greece, published by Birdwing.

For mammalogists, we have the second edition of <u>Pine Martens</u> from Whittet Books and <u>Cattle Breeds of the World - A Classification: Origin, History, Genetics and Morphology</u> from Brill, while for herpetologists, we have <u>A Guide to Land Snakes of Singapore: with Interesting Related Species</u> from Natural History Publications Borneo.

Botanists can look out for Identification Guide to the Non-Native Invasive Plants of Britain and Ireland, due in April from Pelagic Publishing; the second edition of Roger Phillips's long out-of-print 1983 book Trees of North America, Europe, the UK & Ireland, due in May from Pan Macmillan; and the paperback of Simon Barnes's <u>How To Be a Bad Botanist</u>, due in April from Simon & Schuster. There is a little moss theme this month, with Princeton University Press announcing <u>Mosses</u>, Liverworts, and Hornworts of the World: A Guide to Every Order for August and Pelagic Publishing Moss Safari: Exploring the Secret Life in Moss for May.

Finally, a brief roundup of notable titles on wildlife conservation and other environmental issues. Two new August titles are Endemic: Exploring the Wildlife Unique to Britain from Bloomsbury and Roy Scranton's Impasse: Climate Change and the Limits of Progress from Stanford University Press. Three paperback rereleases are Peter Scott and the Birth of Modern Conservation from Quiller Publishing; Nature Conservation in Europe: Approaches and Lessons, due in May from Cambridge University Press; and The Green Ages: Medieval Innovations in Sustainability, due in August from Profile Books
