# April 2023 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the April 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have an excellent list of bird books to announce this month. In September, Princeton University Press will publish Terns of North America: A Photographic Guide while Penguin Random House South Africa will release the second edition of Guide to Seabirds of Southern Africa: A Practical Guide to Animal Tracking in Southern Africa. Rainforest Publications has just released two laminated fold-out guides that NHBS distributes: Costa Rica: Hummingbirds and Costa Rica: Birds of the Pacific Rainforest. Both are bilingual in English and Spanish. Several notable releases cover bird biology, including the second edition of

The Little Owl: Conservation, Ecology and Behavior of Athene noctua, due in August from Cambridge University Press; and two recent back issues of the annual magazine Wildfowl, number 71 and number 72, that NHBS now stocks. Last in the bird line-up is What an Owl Knows: The New Science of the World's Most Enigmatic Birds, which is due in July from Oneworld Publications and will be written by Jennifer Ackerman.

On the subject of other vertebrate groups, we have one book each. New Holland Publishers will release the 4th edition of <u>Strahan's The Mammals of Australia</u> this month. Edition Chimaira has just published <u>A Field Guide to the Reptiles and Amphibians of Kenya</u>. A new publisher to our range is Reef Ranch Publishing who will release <u>The Complete Reef Aquarist: For Hobbyists</u>, the <u>Trade and Academics</u> in July. This is an in-depth tome that uniquely contains practical information of use to scientists working with fish, aquarists maintaining public displays, and those involved in import and export of fishes.

Entomologists can look out for British & Irish Butterfly Rarities: Migrants, Extinctions & Introductions, due in August from NatureBureau; Insects of the Sefton Coast, which has just been published by the Lancashire & Cheshire Fauna Society; and two new books from Princeton University Press that are both due in August:

Beetles of the World: A Natural History and The Complete Insect: Anatomy, Physiology, Evolution, and Ecology. Two further interesting books on other invertebrates, both due in August, are Field Guide to Scorpions of South Africa from Penguin Random House South Africa and The Lives of Octopuses and Their Relatives: A Natural History of Cephalopods from Princeton University Press. The latter will be authored by Danna Staaf who previously wrote the excellent popular book Squid Empire.

For botanists and mycologists, we have three noteworthy books on this month's list. Geoffrey Kibby will release the final instalment of Mushrooms and Toadstools of Britain & Europe, Volume 4 Agarics, Part 3 in May. Meanwhile, the Field Studies Council has just released the new laminated fold-out guide Flowers of Hills and Heathlands and the third edition of their AlDGAP guide British Plant Galls. Another relevant title is the new Crossbill Guide: Rhodope Mountains, Bulgaria that covers both its flora and fauna.

We have an outstanding list of conservation titles this month. Cambridge University Press will release Zoo Studies: Living Collections, Their Animals and Visitors in June and Ecology and Conservation of Mountain Birds in August, the latter part of their Ecology, Biodiversity and Conservation series. Routledge has announced Species, Science and Society: The Role of Systematic Biology for July which promises to be a clarion call for the importance of traditional systematics and comparative morphology. A similarly topical title in light of recent discussions on trophy hunting, due in May from James Currey, is

Conservation, Markets & the Environment in Southern and Eastern Africa: Commodifying the 'Wild', which casts a critical eye on the practice of conservation by commodification. Witness Books will publish the paperback of Rewilding the Sea: How to Save Our Oceans in June and we just received stock of the Birdlife International report State of the World's Birds 2022: Insights and Solutions for the Biodiversity Crisis. A further three titles on related environmental issues are

Death by Nature? Understanding Wildlife Diseases, due September from Apollo; Michael Mann's new book

Our Fragile Moment: How Lessons from Earth's Past Can Help Us Survive the Climate Crisis, due September from Public Affairs Press; and

Lakes in the Anthropocene: Reflections on Tracking Ecosystem Change in the Arctic, which has just been published by the International Ecology Institute as part of their Excellence in Ecology series.

Some notable new books on ecology and evolution are African Ark: Mammals, Landscape and the Ecology of a Continent, just published by Wits University Press; the third edition of Island Biogeography: Geo-Environmental Dynamics, Ecology, Evolution, Human Impact, and Conservation, due in June from Oxford University Press; and a reprint of Katrina van Grouw's lavishly illustrated Unnatural Selection, due in June from Princeton University Press.

Finally, three books in our good reads category are The Man Who Organized Nature: The Life of Linnaeus, due in September from Princeton University Press, and two paperback reissues: Where the Wildflowers Grow: My Botanical Journey Through Britain and Ireland, due in May from Hodder & Stoughton, and The Flow: Rivers, Water and Wildness, due in August from Bloomsbury Publishing.
