Welcome to the April 2026 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have some excellent bird books to start with. The Sound Approach Team previously published books under their own banner, but the second edition of [The Sound Approach to Birding: The Ultimate Guide to Understanding Bird Sound](#) will be released in April by HarperCollins. Also just released in its second edition is the Portuguese guide [Aves do Sudeste do Brasil: Guia de Identificação](#), published by the author Daniel Mello. In September, Princeton University Press will publish [The Atlas of North America's Migratory Birds: Tracking Movement Across Seasons and Continents](#), and Helm will publish the second edition of [Birds of the Mediterranean: A Photographic Guide](#).

Entomologists can look out for the reprint of [Beetles of Britain and Ireland, Volume 4: Cerambycidae to Curculionidae](#), due in May from the Field Studies Council, and [The Glow-worm: The Natural History of *Lampyris noctiluca*](#), due in September from Pelagic Publishing. The Royal Entomological Society will publish the [RES Handbook: Fungus Gnats \(Diptera: Bolitophilidae, Ditomyiidae, Diadocidiidae, Keroplatidae, and Mycetophilidae excluding Mycetophilinae\)](#) in August, which complements the earlier 2022 handbook.

Botanists will welcome the third edition of [Collins Wild Flower Guide: The Most Complete Guide to the Wild Flowers of Britain and Ireland](#), due in May from HarperCollins. We just received stock of [A Checklist of Vascular Plants for the Korean Peninsula Flora](#), published by Designpost. For mycologists, we can announce Geoffrey Kibby's [Cup Fungi and Other Ascomycetes of Britain & Europe: An Introductory Guide](#), which is due in April.

On the topic of conservation, we have [Rewilding Glen Affric](#), due in September from Pelagic Publishing, and the paperback of [The Great Auk: Its Extraordinary Life, Hideous Death and Mysterious Afterlife](#), due in June from Bloomsbury Sigma.

Finally, we have a range of natural history titles. Apollo has just published [The Secret World of Twilight: A Natural History of Dusk and Dawn](#), while Pelagic Publishing has announced [Wild Alps: The Natural History of Europe's High Mountains](#) for September. To celebrate David Attenborough's 100th birthday this May, HarperCollins is rereleasing paperback versions of [Life on Earth](#), [Living Planet](#), and [The Trials of Life](#) in April. In the same vein, The Lutterworth Press is reissuing the Zoo Quest books, starting with [Zoo Quest to Guyana](#) in May, [Zoo Quest for a Dragon](#) in July, and [Zoo Quest in Paraguay](#) in September
