Welcome to the May 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

For birdwatchers, we have a number of excellent new titles. Princeton University Press has announced Birds of China for October, and John Beaufoy will release

An Identification Guide to Garden Birds of Britain and North-West Europe in May, followed by A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Myanmar and

A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Nepal in September. Dorling Kindersley Canada has just released the third edition of both Birds of Western Canada and

Birds of Eastern Canada. Lastly, in October there is the paperback release of Birdgirl: A Young Environmentalist Looks to the Skies in Search of a Better Future, published

by Vintage, and another bird monograph written by Stephen Moss and published by Square Peg, this time The Owl: A Biography.

Readers interested in mammals can look out for <u>Sound Identification of Terrestrial Mammals of Britain & Ireland</u>, due in September from Pelagic Publishing, and the tenthanniversary edition of <u>The Song of the Ape</u>, which was just published by Elgin Press. For herpetologists, there is A Naturalist's Guide to the Reptiles & Amphibians of The Philippines, due in September from John Beaufoy.

There are a number of excellent insect guides, with a focus on Lepidoptera this month. Available now are

Moths of Europe, Volume 7: Microlepidoptera 1: Micropterigidae to Tortricidae from NAP Editions and Hesperiidae Part 1: Subfamilies Coeliadinae and Heteropterinae from Omnes Artes, which is part of their ongoing Guide to the Butterflies of the Palearctic Region series. Due in September are Southern African Moths & Their Caterpillars from Pelagic Publishing and A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies of the Philippines from John Beaufoy Publishing. Two other interesting insect guides, both due in October, are Hoverflies of Britain and North-West Europe: A Photographic Guide from Bloomsbury, and the second edition of Ants from Pelagic Publishing, which is part of the Naturalists' Handbooks series.

This month we also have a number of general wildlife guides to areas and countries around the globe. Pelagic Publishing will release A Wildlife Guide to Georgia in September, Rolf Stange has just released the fifth edition of Spitsbergen - Svalbard: A Complete Guide Around the Arctic Archipelago, and Natural History Publications Borneo has just published A Field Guide to Tawau Hills Park. Closer to home, Field Guide to Alpine Wildlife is due in October from Bloomsbury, while we have just received stock of the privately published Porthcawl Naturally: Landscape and Wildlife Around a Welsh Seaside Town.

Botanists will be interested in Wild Flowers of Coastal Andalucía: A Photographic Field Guide, which was just released by Browndown Publications, and four new titles from Natural History Publications Borneo, all of which are available now: <u>Timonius in Borneo</u>, <u>Impatiens of Thailand</u>, <u>A Guide to Market Fruits of Borneo</u>, and the second edition of A Guide to Wild Fruits of Borneo. A closely related palaeobotany title that is hard to find is

The Catskill Fossil Forest: A Guide to the Storied History of the Devonian Gilboa Forest and More Recent Discoveries, published by the Gilboa Historical Society Press, which tells the story behind the world's oldest petrified forest.

Finally, we have two titles dealing with conservation biology: Pelagic Publishing is releasing Mark Avery's next book Reflections: What Wildlife Needs and How to Provide It in July while Cambridge University Press has announced Conservation in the Context of a Changing World: Concepts, Strategies, and Evidence for September. On other environmental issues, there are four noteworthy paperback reissues: Life on the Rocks: Building a Future for Coral Reefs was just reissued by Riverhead Books, Fen, Bog & Swamp: A Short History of Peatland Destruction and Its Role in the Climate Crisis is coming in September from Fourth Estate, The Chemical Age: How Chemists Fought Famine and Disease, Killed Millions, and Changed Our Relationship with the Earth is due in October from the University of Chicago Press, and The Darkness Manifesto: How Light Pollution Threatens the Ancient Rhythms of Life has been announced for November by Vintage.
