Welcome to the May 2026 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We lead this month with new bird titles. Helm has announced [Kingfishers of the World: A Photographic Guide](#) for October. Closer to home, we just received stock of [The Birds of Bedfordshire](#), published by the Bedfordshire Natural History Society. Several field guides are being updated with new editions, including the third edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Aotearoa New Zealand](#), due in September from John Beaufoy, and the seventh edition of [RSPB Birds of Britain and Europe: The Definitive Photographic Field Guide](#), out now from Dorling Kindersley.

For other vertebrate groups, we have a few books each. We just received stock of [A Photographic Guide to Prey Remains in Otter Spraint](#), a practical, spiral-bound guide from the Mammal Society in the same vein as their recent guide to owl pellets. New editions coming in October are the third edition of [Marine Mammals of the World: A Comprehensive Guide to Their Identification](#), published by Academic Press, and the second edition of [Amphibians of Europe, North Africa & the Middle East: A Photographic Guide](#), published by Bloomsbury.

Where entomology is concerned, we will shortly have stock of [The Macro-moths of Warwickshire: A 2026 Review](#), a new edition of the 2006 book *The Larger Moths of Warwickshire*, published by the Butterfly Conservation Warwickshire branch. [A Naturalist's Guide to the Insects of Aotearoa New Zealand](#) is due in September from John Beaufoy and [World Catalogue of Insects, Volume 18: Adult Haliplidae of the World](#) is due in June from Brill. In the category of other invertebrates there is [The Natural History of the Crustacea, Volume 10: Ecology and Conservation](#), the final volume in this series from Oxford University Press.

For botanists, we have a range of titles on British flora this month. We have just received stock of The Field Studies Council's new AIDGAP Guide, [Sedges: A Guide to Identification Using Vegetative Characters](#). Two privately published books are Jon Holt's [Britain's Dandelions: A Photographic Guide](#) and Michael Crawley's [London's Plants](#). Meanwhile, The Choir Press has just published [Botany for Beginners: A Guide to Identifying the Most Common British Wildflowers](#). Looking abroad, Libreria della Natura has published the bilingual English-Italian two-volume flora [Grasses of Italy](#), while the Botanischer Garten und Botanisches Museum Berlin has published Volume 28 of their [Flora de la República de Cuba, Series A: Plantas Vasculares: Dryopteridaceae, Marattiaceae](#). For mycologists, then, we have [Corticoid Fungi of Europe, Volume 2: Hastodontia – Quasiphlebia](#).

A final miscellany of titles includes the next New Naturalist, [Microworlds](#), due in August from HarperCollins; the fifth edition of the [Crossbill Guide: Extremadura, Spain](#); the paperback of Tristan Gooley's [The Hidden Seasons: A Calendar of Nature's Clues and Signs](#), due in June from Hodder & Stoughton; and [Wildlife Photographer of the Year, Portfolio 36](#), due in October from the London Natural History Museum.
