

June 2024 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the June 2024 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open with a selection of bird titles. Bloomsbury will publish [Owls of Europe: Biology, Identification and Conservation](#) in November, a translation of a book originally published in German. Lynx Edicions is publishing the second edition of [Birds of Vietnam](#) in July, which updates the first edition published six years ago in 2018. Lastly, Stephen Moss continues his collection of bird biographies published by Square Peg; [The Starling: A Biography](#) is up next in October. For herpetologists, we have one notable title: the University of Chicago Press is reissuing the splendid [Eye of Newt and Toe of Frog, Adder's Fork and Lizard's Leg: The Lore and Mythology of Amphibians and Reptiles](#) in paperback in October, following on from its original publication in hardback in 2015.

On the subject of insects and other invertebrates, we have three noteworthy titles. Princeton University Press continues its "A Guide to Every Family" series with [Moths of the World: A Guide to Every Family](#), coming in October. The University of Oklahoma Press has announced [The Monarch Butterfly Migration: Its Rise and Fall](#) for August, adding to a small but growing body of literature on this exceptional natural phenomenon. The Field Studies Council, then, just announced the publication of a new fold-out AIDGAP guide: [Guide to the Freshwater Leeches of Britain and Ireland](#). This is a welcome addition to the literature, seeing that the previous guide on this group was published almost a decade ago by the Freshwater Biological Association.

For botanists, we have five notable titles. Starting close to home, we have [Guide to Waterside Flowers](#), a fold-out guide which has just been released by the Field Studies Council. Particularly exciting is the second edition of [Field Guide to the Orchids of Europe and the Mediterranean](#), which will be published by the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, in July and follows the first edition published in 2019. Looking further afield, Yale University Press has announced [Smithsonian Trees of North America](#), due in August, while Natural History Publications Borneo has just published [Begonias of Thailand](#). A final interesting title in this selection is [Birds, Bats, and Blooms: The Coevolution of Vertebrate Pollinators and Their Plants](#), which will be published in November by the University of Arizona Press.

Turning to wildlife conservation and other environmental issues, we have a range of important and thought-provoking titles. The Field Studies Council has just released their [WCA Survey Pack: Woodland Condition Assessment](#), a bundle of five fold-out guides to carry out standardised surveys to assess the condition of woodlands. Johns Hopkins University Press has announced [Before They Vanish: Saving Nature's Populations – and Ourselves](#), which is due in November. Also due that month is Vince Beiser's [Power Metal: The Race for the Resources That Will Shape the Future](#), published by Wildfire. Given that his first book, *The World in a Grain*, was an eye-opening reportage about our consumption of sand, this should be an excellent piece of environmental journalism. Another thought-provoking book is Carl Safina's [Alfie & Me: What Owls Know, What Humans Believe](#), the paperback of which will be published in November by W. W. Norton & Co. Much more than a natural history memoir, this is a piercing analysis of the philosophical traditions that have led to our relationship with nature in the developed world.

Three noteworthy titles on ecology and evolutionary biology are [Fenland Nature](#), to be published by Pelagic Publishing, and [Evolution Evolving: The Developmental Origins of Adaptation and Biodiversity](#) and an updated edition of [40 Years of Evolution: Darwin's Finches on Daphne Major Island](#), both coming from Princeton University Press. All three of these books are scheduled for publication in November.

We conclude this month's selection with some excellent natural and environmental history titles. Doubleday has announced John Lewis-Stempel's book [England: A Natural History](#) for October, while Yale University Press will publish Jeremy Mynott's [The Story of Nature: A Human History](#) in September. Two more thematic titles are [The Green Ages: Medieval Innovations in Sustainability](#), due in August from Profile Books, and [Hoof Beats: How Horses Shaped Human History](#), due in September from the University of California Press.
