Welcome to the June 2026 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

Mammal researchers can look forward to [The Pine Marten Conservation Handbook](#), which will be released imminently by Vincent Wildlife Trust. For ornithologists and birdwatchers, we have three notable books in the pipeline: Helm will publish [North American Landbirds in the Western Palearctic](#) in October, John Beaufoy will publish [A Field Guide to the East Asian–Australasian Flyway](#) in November, and Firefly Books has announced [Parrots of the World: Every Species, Everywhere](#) for October.

We have an especially strong entomology selection this month. Richard Lewington is well-known and loved for his entomological artwork, and Bloomsbury is compiling his lepidopteran-themed art in a large-format, close-to-A4 book, [Richard Lewington's Moths & Butterflies of the British Isles](#), to be released in November. We have just received stock of [The Macro-moths of Warwickshire: A 2026 Review](#), published by Butterfly Conservation Warwickshire. This is an update to their 2006 book *The Larger Moths of Warwickshire*. The supply of titles published by CSIRO in Australia was problematic for some time after the demise of their UK distributor. We have established an alternative supply route, so we can continue to offer these books, including [Australian Beetles, Volume 3: Polyphaga \(Part 2\)](#), which is the third part in this four-volume series. Esperiana Verlag has just published [Moths of Africa – Systematic and Illustrated Catalogue of the Heterocera of Africa, Volume 5: Genus Prasinocyma \(Geometridae\)](#). August will see the paperback release of the [RES Handbook: British Dolichopodidae \(Diptera\)](#), published by the Royal Entomological Society, while November will see the paperback release of [Honey Bee Biology](#) by Princeton University Press. Lastly, John Beaufoy will publish the third edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies of Australia](#) in November. In other invertebrate news, Pelagic Publishing has announced [Slugs: A Natural and Cultural History](#) for November.

Two notable botany titles are [Field Guide to the Wild Flowers of Crete](#), due in October from the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew, and [Flora of Thailand, Volume 15, Part 2: Rubiaceae \(Genera 46-82\)](#), which has just been published by the Forest Herbarium in Thailand.

Finally, two conservation-related titles are a reissue of [RHS Wildlife of a Garden: A Thirty-year Study](#), just published by CABI, and the paperback of [Tigers Between Empires: The Journey to Save the Siberian Tiger from Extinction](#), due in November from Penguin Books. Last but not least, HarperCollins has announced [Churchyards](#) for November, which (all going well) will be volume 152 in the New Naturalist series.
