## July 2023 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the July 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We start this month, as always, with notable books on vertebrates. Ornithologists can look out for The Osprey, a new Poyser monograph coming in December from Bloomsbury, and Blue-Footed Boobies: Sibling Conflict & Sexual Infidelity on a Tropical Island, coming in September from Oxford University Press. Lighter bird literature is coming in the shape of Carl Safina's Alfie & Me: What Owls Know, What Humans Believe, due in November from W.W. Norton, and Bird Photographer of the Year, Collection 8, due in September from HarperCollins. For herpetologists, we have two titles that are both available now:

Snakes of the Syrian Arab Republic from Edition Chimaira and Saving Snakes: Snakes and the Evolution of a Field Naturalist from the University of Virginia Press. Then we have one mammal book from Crocuta Publishers, Fast Cats of Red Sands: The Lives of Kalahari Cheetahs and Their Researchers, and an identification swatch on fish from the National Biodiversity Data Centre in Ireland, Intertidal Fish and Invertebrates.

For entomologists, there are several exciting titles in the pipeline. Bloomsbury will publish the second edition of Field Guide to the Micro-Moths of Great Britain and Ireland in December, which will again be illustrated by Richard Lewington. Other identification guides are Tasmanian Mayflies: Identification, Ecology, Behaviour and Imitation, due in September from CSIRO; A Naturalist's Guide to the Insects of India, due in October from John Beaufoy Publishing; and Commonly Encountered Moths, another identification swatch from the National Biodiversity Data Centre that is available now. Lastly, an accessible book on bee biology is Hairy-Foot, Long-Tongue: Solitary Bees, Biodiversity & Evolution in Your Backyard, which will be released in October by Whittles Publishing.

There are some cracking titles on plants to announce this month. We are particularly excited by the fourth edition of <u>The Herbarium Handbook</u>, coming in September from the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew. They are furthermore publishing <u>The Important Plant Areas of Mozambique</u> and the second edition of <u>Guide to the Flowers of Western China</u> in October. Two books that have just been released are <u>Endemic Plant Genera of Borneo</u> from Natural History Publications Borneo and <u>Flora Malesiana</u>, <u>Series 2: Ferns and Fern Allies</u>, <u>Volume 5: Hymenophyllaceae</u> from the National Parks Board Singapore. A related book on palaeobotany is <u>Quaternary Vegetation Dynamics of Europe</u>, which has just been published by Verlag Paul Haupt.

On the topic of climate change and related issues, we have three books from Cambridge University Press:

How to Fix a Broken Planet: Advice for Surviving the 21st Century and two parts of the sixth IPCC report, Climate Change 2021 - The Physical Science Basis and Climate Change 2022 - Impacts, Adaptation and Vulnerability. Additionally, Duckworth Overlook has just published

The Case for Nature: Pioneering Solutions for the Other Planetary Crisis, Icon Books will publish the paperback of

Buy Better, Consume Less: Create Real Environmental Change in September, and Routledge recently published

Radical Ecological Economics and Accounting to Save the Planet: The Failure of Mainstream Economists. On biodiversity, we have two titles from Routledge:
