Welcome to the July 2026 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

Birdwatchers can look out for the third edition of the Helm Field Guide [Birds of Costa Rica](#), due in November from Helm. Stephen Moss is writing the seventh book in his series of bird biographies, [The Puffin: A Biography](#), which is due in October from Chatto & Windus. For mammal watchers, we have the large, 664-page field guide [Mammals of India](#), just published by HarperCollins India; [Mammals of Middle and South America: History, Biogeography, Conservation, Volume 1](#), due in December from Springer; and [Primates of Southern Africa: Pocket Identification Guide](#), published by Re:wild and in stock now. Herpetological literature this month includes [A Photographic Field Guide to the Lizards of Thailand](#), just published by the Rabbit in the Moon Foundation, and the third edition of [Tadpoles and Frogs of Australia](#), due in November from New Holland Publishers.

Turning to marine fauna, the NRF-South African Institute for Aquatic Biodiversity published the five-volume set [Coastal Fishes of the Western Indian Ocean](#) back in 2022, initially in digital format only. We recently learned that, in the end, this has been made available in print. Another hard-to-find title is [Marine Seashells of Qatar and the Arabian Gulf \(Bivalvia\)](#), recently published by Hamad Bin Khalifa University Press.

A major botanical publication that is in the pipeline is [The Fenland Flora](#), a two-volume set due in October from NatureBureau. The Botanical Society of Britain & Ireland has just published the second edition of their BSBI Handbook [Whitebeams, Rowans and Service Trees of Britain and Ireland](#). Two new books from Natural History Publications Borneo are [A Guide to Hoya of New Guinea](#), which is out now, and [The Last Colonial Officer of North Borneo: The Enduring Legacy of Anthony Lamb](#), which is due in July. The Instituto Multidisciplinario de Biología Vegetal has just released another volume in their ongoing Spanish-language Flora Argentina with [Volume 11\(1\): Dicotyledoneae: Fabaceae \(p.p.\): Caesalpinioideae, Cercidoideae, Detarioideae, Dialioideae](#). Lastly, for mycologists, Geoffrey Kibby has just published [The Genus Russula in Great Britain: With Keys to Species](#), the definitive identification work on this group.

Finally, turning to the topic of conservation biology, Pelagic Publishing has just released the paperback of [Living with Lynx: Sharing Landscapes with Big Cats, Wolves and Bears](#) and will publish [John Wolley's Garefowl Books: The Aukward Birth of Anthropogenic Extinction](#) in November. Emily Cunningham's [Our Ocean to Save: How You Can Protect Our Greatest Climate Ally](#) is due in October from One Boat, an imprint of Pan Macmillan. Lastly, Crossbill Guides has announced the second edition of their guide to [North-East Poland: Biebrza, Bia?owie?a, Narew and Wigry – Poland](#) for publication in November.
