## August 2022 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the August 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

Two interesting mammal titles this month are the identification swatch Ireland's Biodiversity: Terrestrial Mammals, published by the Irish National Biodiversity Data Centre, and Michael Stephen Clark's book The Fragmented World of the Mongoose Lemur. Those interested in birds can look out for 101 Curious Tales of East African Birds: A Brief Introduction to Tropical Ornithology, due in November from Pelagic Publishing, and In a Class of Their Own: A Detailed Examination of Avian Forms and Functions, due in January from Springer.

On the subject of insects and other invertebrates, there is a diverse selection this month. Available now are <u>British Coleopterists</u>: <u>Biographies</u>, <u>Collections</u>, <u>Sources</u> from Malthouse Books, the second edition of <u>Common Micro-Moths</u> of <u>Berkshire</u>: <u>A Guide to Identification of Some Common Micro-Moths</u> from the Berkshire Moth Group Publishing (the species included are common across the whole of South England), the second edition of the fold-out guide <u>Harvestmen of the British Isles</u> from the Field Studies Council, and <u>The Conchological Albums – Terrestrial Molluscs</u>, Volume 10: <u>Camaenidae</u> (6) from ConchBooks. Planktonia: The Nightly Migration of the Ocean's Smallest Creatures is due in October from Firefly Books.

For botanists, there are two interesting books due in January: <u>Seaweeds of the World: A Guide to Every Order</u> from Princeton University Press and the paperback of <u>The Treeline: The Last Forest and the Future of Life on Earth</u> from Vintage.

We have a large selection of titles on wildlife conservation. Practical issues are covered by <u>Thermal Imaging for Wildlife Applications</u>, due in January from Pelagic Publishing, <u>A Practical Guide to DNA-Based Methods for Biodiversity Assessment</u>, just published by Pensoft, and <u>Solid Air: Invisible Killer: Saving Billions of Birds from Windows</u>, released by Hancock House Publishers. More theoretical is <u>What Species Mean: A User's Guide to the Units of Biodiversity</u>, which has just been published in paperback by CRC Press. Two books covering regional issues are <u>Coral Reefs of Australia: Perspectives from Beyond the Water's Edge</u>, due in November from CSIRO, and <u>Masters of the Lost Land: The Untold Story of the Fight to Own the Amazon</u>, due in January from Atlantic Books. A diverse range of environmental issues are covered by the paperback of <u>How to Avoid a Climate Disaster: The Solutions We Have and the Breakthroughs We Need</u>, due in August from Penguin Books, <u>The Progress Illusion: Reclaiming Our Future from the Fairytale of Economics</u>, due in December from Island Press, and <u>Salmon Wars: The Dark Underbelly of Our Favorite Fish</u>, due in August from St Martin's Press.

For ecologists, we have <u>Cave Biodiversity: Speciation and Diversity of Subterranean Fauna</u>, due in January from Johns Hopkins University Press, and <u>Harbour Ecology: Environment and Development in Poole Harbour</u>, due in September from Pelagic Publishing. Two paperback rereleases are <u>Swamplands: Tundra Beavers</u>, Quaking Bogs, and the Improbable World of Peat, due in August from Island Press, and <u>A Natural History of the Future: What the Laws of Biology Tell Us About the Destiny of the Human Species</u>, due in January from John Muray.

#### Lastly, we have a smattering of books covering different topics. Readers interested in nature writing can look out for Ronald Blythe's

Next to Nature: A Lifetime in the English Countryside, due in October from John Murray. Two popular science titles due in January are <u>Viruses: A Natural History</u> from Princeton University Press, and <u>If Nietzsche Were a Narwhal: What Animal Intelligence Reveals about Human Stupidity</u> from Hodder & Stoughton. On history of science, we have <u>Coenraad Jacob Temminck and the Emergence of Systematics (1800–1850</u>), recently published by Brill. Finally, seeing the wide use of the statistical programming language R in biological and ecological circles, of note is the third edition of <u>The R Book</u>, due in September from John Wiley.
