

August 2024 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the August 2024 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

This month's highlights include some exciting mammal titles. Pelagic Publishing has announced two titles for January: [Identifying Bats of Britain and Ireland: A Field Worker's Guide](#), which should become a staple guide for bat workers, and [Pine Marten: The Secret Life of *Martes martes*](#). John Beaufoy will release two mammal guides to Asia, both due in September: [A Photographic Guide to the Wildlife of Sri Lanka](#) and the third edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Mammals of Southeast Asia](#).

For birdwatchers, we have three new books. We have stock of [The Norfolk Plover: A Study of the Stone-Curlew](#) published by Wild Breckland Books. September will see the publication of the fourth edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Australia](#) by John Beaufoy, and [How Birds Fly: The Science & Art of Avian Flight](#) by Firefly Books.

Herpetologists will be excited to learn that the long-running Handbook of Zoology, published by De Gruyter, has announced a new subseries covering reptiles. [The first volume: General Biology, Archosauria, Chelonia](#), is due for publication in August. John Beaufoy, meanwhile, has announced [A Field Guide to the Snakes of Australia](#), due in September.

Turning to marine biology, we have a range of books. Academic Press has announced a completely revamped version of Ridgway and Harrison's Handbook of Marine Mammals, originally released in six volumes between 1981 and 1998, with [the first volume on coastal dolphins and porpoises](#) scheduled for January. That month will also see the release of two field guides from Bloomsbury: [Marine Life of the North Sea and English Channel](#) and [Field Guide to British Fish: Freshwater and Marine](#). Lastly, we have stock of [Nudibranchs and Other Sea Slugs of the Azores](#) published by Letras Lavadas Edições.

For entomologists, we have stock of a new AIDGAP guide from the Field Studies Council, [Orthoptera and Dermaptera: \(The Grasshoppers, Groundhoppers, Crickets and Earwigs of Central and Northern Britain and Ireland\)](#). John Beaufoy has announced two further guides for September, [A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies of Hong Kong](#) and [A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies & Moths of Aotearoa New Zealand](#). Sutherland House has announced an interesting critique of urban beekeeping with [The Honey Trap: How the Good Intentions of Urban Beekeepers Risk Ecological Disaster](#), due in October. Lastly, we have just received stock of the bilingual English / French butterfly monograph [French Guyana Riodinids / Les Riodinidae de Guyane](#).

There are some excellent new botany titles. Kreutz Publishers is about to release [Orchids of Europe, North Africa and the Middle East](#), an enormous 1200-page synopsis to an even larger planned 6-volume work, while the Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew will publish [Field Guide to the Wild Flowers of the Canary Islands](#) in October. Cambridge University Press has just released the two-volume treatise *Evolution of the Arborescent Gymnosperms: Pattern, Process and Diversity*, with [volume 1 focusing on the northern hemisphere](#) and [volume 2 on the southern hemisphere](#). It is the culmination of 54 years of research, teaching and field study by the author who sadly passed away just after completing the manuscript. On the subject of mycology, we have just received stock of [Synopsis Fungorum, Volume 49: Poroid Fungi of North America](#).

Three conservation-focused highlights this month are [Coexistence: Learning to Live with Lynx, Wolves and Bears](#) and [Africa's Threatened Rhinos: A History of Exploitation and Conservation](#), both due in January from Pelagic Publishing, and the paperback of [Birds, Beasts and Bedlam: Turning My Farm into an Ark for Lost Species](#), due in September from Chelsea Green.

Finally, on miscellaneous other subjects, we have stock of [The Back to the Past Museum Guide to Trilobites II](#), and catalogued [Alexander von Humboldt: A Concise Biography](#), due in January from Princeton University Press, and [Shopping All the Way to the Woods: How the Outdoor Industry Sold Nature to America](#), out now from Yale University Press.
