Welcome to the August 2025 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open with a range of mammal field guides and faunas, with a focus on the Americas. Bloomsbury will publish [Field Guide to Whales, Dolphins and Porpoises of North America](#) in January, Lynx has announced [Mammals of the Southwestern United States: Biology of Native and Some Extirpated, Extinct, and Introduced Species](#) for October, and the University Press of Colorado will publish the second edition of [Bats of the Rocky Mountain West: Natural History, Ecology, and Conservation](#) in August. Moving over to South America, there is the second volume of the Spanish-language mammal fauna [Mamíferos de Argentina, Tomo 2: Cetáceos, Xenartros, Carnívoros y Lagomorfos](#). Of related interest is [The Evolution of Cetacean Societies: Uncovering the Social Complexity of Whales and Dolphins](#), which will be published in January by the University of Chicago Press.

For birdwatchers, we have several guides and reports to destinations near – the [Lancashire Bird Report 2024](#) is due in September – and far: Lynx has just published the second edition of [Birds of New Guinea: Including Bismarck Archipelago and Bougainville](#), while CSIRO has published the second edition of [Finding Australian Birds: A Field Guide to Birding Locations](#). For ornithologists, we have [Bird Brains and Behavior: A Synthesis](#), due in August from MIT Press, and [Birding with AI: Concepts and Projects for Ornithology](#), due in October from Pelagic Publishing.

Herpetologists have two noteworthy titles to look out for. Biotope has announced the [Handbook of Amphibians of French Guyana](#) for September, while CRC Press has completed its Amphibians of Ecuador series with the publication of [Volume 4: Phyllomedusidae, Leptodactylidae, Ceratophryidae, Hemiphractidae, Eleutherodactylidae, Centrolenidae, Gymnophiona and Caudata](#).

For entomologists, we have a diverse spread of books this month. Close to home, NatureBureau has just published [The Beetles of Oxfordshire](#) and in September will publish [Spiders & Harvestmen of Yorkshire: An Atlas](#). Three titles on Orthoptera are the [Field Guide to the Grasshoppers of Great Britain and Ireland: Grasshoppers, Crickets, Earwigs, Cockroaches, Stick-Insects and Mantids](#), due in January from Bloomsbury; [Grasshoppers, Locusts, and Crickets of the World](#), due in February from Princeton University Press; and [A Synonymic Catalogue of Crickets in the World \(Insecta: Orthoptera: Grylloidea\)](#), published by Science Press in China. For Lepidoptera, we have two titles: Princeton University Press will publish [Moths of Western North America](#) in January, while Storm Entomological Publishing has just released [The Jewel Butterflies: A Monograph of the Lycaenid Genus Hypochrysops](#). Staying with the invertebrates more generally for a moment, De Gruyter will publish [Handbook of Zoology: Platyhelminthes, Volume 2: Free-Living Taxa: Tricladida](#) in December.

Botanists can look out for [Brambles of Scotland: An Illustrated Field Handbook](#), a new handbook published by the Botanical Society of Britain & Ireland. For mycologists, we have two noteworthy titles: [Alpine Mushrooms of North America: Treasures Above Treeline](#) [sic], due in December from the University of Illinois Press, and [The Lichens of Greece: Including Lichenicolous Fungi](#), which has just been published by Koeltz Botanical Books.

Moving on to the subject of wildlife and environmental conservation, we have several thought-provoking titles. MIT Press will publish a critique of the concept of ecosystem services in January with [Biologists Unite: The Rise and Fall of Ecosystem Services](#), while the University Press of Kentucky has recently reissued [Smokescreen: Debunking Wildfire Myths to Save Our Forests and Our Climate](#) in paperback. Routledge has announced [Rewilding and Reintroductions in Britain: Human Interactions with Conservation](#) for November, while Springer will publish [The National Parks of Indonesia](#) in August.

For ecologists, we have several site and wildlife guides this month. NatureBureau is publishing [The Wildlife of the Avalon Marshes](#) in October, Crossbill is publishing the third editions of its guides to [Iceland](#) (due September) and the [Spanish Pyrenees](#) (due November), and Princeton University Press continues its Habitats of the World series in January with [Habitats of Europe](#).

On the subject of palaeontology and evolutionary biology, there are some heavy hitters coming in January from Princeton University Press with [Elephants and Their Fossil Relatives: A 60 Million Year Journey](#) and the three-volume Princeton Encyclopedia of Dinosaurs that is divided over [ornithischians](#), [sauropods](#), and [theropods](#). January will also see the publication by Johns Hopkins University Press of [The Rise of Mammals in Africa](#).

A final miscellany of titles covers a range of subject areas. For readers of environmental history there is Donald Worster's [Be Fruitful and Multiply: How Fertility and Innovation Have Changed Humankind and the Earth](#), due in January from Yale University Press, and for readers of the history of science there is Gillen D'Arcy Wood's [The Wake of HMS Challenger: How a Legendary Victorian Voyage Tells the Story of Our Oceans' Decline](#), due in January from Princeton University Press. Pelagic Publishing has reissued two books in paperback: the nature writing title [Rhythms of Nature: Wildlife and Wild Places Between the Moors](#), and the popular science book [Invisible Friends: How Microbes Shape our Lives and the World around Us](#). Finally, two practical titles for biologists of all stripes are [Essentials of Light Microscopy](#), due in November from Oxford University Press, and [The Data Management Workbook: Practical Exercises for Better Organization, Storage and Use of Your Research Data](#), due in December from Pelagic Publishing.
