# September 2022 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the September 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We just received stock of a very nicely produced bird monograph, the privately published <u>Short-Eared Owls: An Extensive Study of Short-Eared Owls in Britain</u>. Beyond this, we have a large selection of bird field guides this month. Helm is publishing three new entries in their Helm Wildlife Guides series: <u>Birds of Borneo</u> (due in November), <u>Birds of Colombia</u> (due in December), and <u>Birds of Ecuador and the Galápagos Islands</u> (due in January). John Beaufoy is publishing the second edition of <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of India</u> in October, while the Zoological Survey of India published <u>Field Guide Birds of India</u> earlier this year. Waterford Press has recently released the second edition of their bilingual fold-out guide <u>Puerto Rico Birds: A Folding Pocket Guide to Familiar Species</u>. For photographers, we have <u>The Beginner's Guide to Photographing Birds</u>: <u>Essential Techniques for Hobbyists and Bird Lovers</u> coming in December from Rocky Nook, a publisher specialising in photography books, and <u>RSPB How to Photograph Garden Birds</u>, coming in January from Bloomsbury. Lastly, Pelagic Publishing will release <u>The Hen Harrier's Year</u> in October.

For other vertebrate groups, we have a few titles. Bloomsbury is publishing <u>Handbook of Manmals of Madagascar</u> in January, which forms a significant update to the author's previous book, Mammals of Madagascar, published in 2007. For herpetologists, we have <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Reptiles & Amphibians Of New Zealand</u>, due in October from John Beaufoy, and we have stock of <u>The Amphibians of Bhutan</u>, just published by Edition Chimaira. A general wildlife guide to both vertebrates and invertebrates is <u>A Photographic Guide to the Wildlife of Seychelles</u>, due in October from John Beaufoy Publishing.

We have a fantastic line-up of entomology books. Field Guide to Flies with Three Pulvilli: Families of Homeodactyla of Northwest Europe from the Dutch Jeugdbondsuitgeverij is due this month, and we have received stock of the privately published Moths of Bhutan, also coming from the Netherlands. Several upcoming field guides are Pocket Guide to the Bumblebees of Great Britain and Ireland, due in January from Bloomsbury; the second edition of A Naturalist's Guide to the Insects of Australia, due in October from John Beaufuy; and Bees of the World: A Guide to Every Family, due in February from Princeton University Press. Lastly, there is Ants: A Visual Guide from Princeton University Press and the paperback of Much Ado About Mothing: A Year Intoxicated by Britain's Rare and Remarkable Moths from Bloomsbury, both due in February.

Two important botany titles are Trees and Woodlands, volume 12 in the British Wildlife Collection that is due in February from Bloomsbury Publishing, and A Field Guide to Tropical Plant Families, due in October from Springer.

For conservation biologists there are two applied titles coming in November: the second edition of

Wildlife Management & Conservation: Contemporary Principles & Practices from John Hopkins University Press and Reproductive Technologies and Biobanking for the Conservation of Amphibians from CRC Press. A good read is the paperback of Tickets for the Ark: From Wasps to Whales – How Do We Choose What to Save?, coming in February from Profile Books. Other environmental issues are discussed in A Poison Like No Other: How Microplastics Corrupted Our Planet and Our Bodies, due in October from Island Press; and the paperbacks of Our Biggest Experiment: A History of the Climate Crisis, due in September from Bloomsbury Sigma; and The Rare Metals War: The Dark Side of Clean Energy and Digital Technologies, due in February from Scribe Publications.

There are three excellent palaeontology books in the pipeline. Siri Scientific Press will publish the in-depth <u>Ichthyosaurs from the Early Jurassic of Britain</u> in November, while there are two noteworthy paperback reissues: <u>Beasts Before Us: The Untold Story of Mammal Origins and Evolution</u>, due in January from Bloomsbury Sigma, and Otherlands: A World in the Making, due in February in Penguin Books.

Finally, three interesting ecology titles are The Darkness Manifesto: On Artificial Light and the Threat to Our Ancient Rhythms, due in November from The Bodley Head; Britain's Living Seas: Our Coastal Wildlife and How We Can Save It, due in January from Bloomsbury Publishing; and Reflections Underwater: A Multidisciplinary Exploration of Coral Reef Wonders, due in February from Pelagic Publishing.

As always, if you are looking for a particular title that we do not yet have in our range, or you would like to suggest a title for NHBS to stock, please do get in touch. In the meantime, stay safe and keep well.
