

# September 2023 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the September 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

This month, we begin with some cracking bird titles. A last-minute drop-in is the fifth edition of Lars Svensson's [Identification Guide to European Passerines](#), published by Avium Förlag. Many bird ringers will no doubt remember the fourth edition with its striking green cover, published back in 1991 (it was only the 889th book added to our catalogue). It has been the standard for over three decades and has now been completely revised and expanded, featuring an additional 38 species. Bloomsbury has furthermore announced [Field Guide to Birds of Greater Southern Africa](#) for February, while the National Library of Australia will publish [The Bird Art of William T. Cooper](#) this October. We just received stock of [Waders of Britain and Ireland](#), a new fold-out guide from the Field Studies Council.

Our mammal selection is heavily biased towards primates this month, courtesy of Global Wildlife Conservation (formerly Conservation International) who are releasing the fifth edition of [Lemurs of Madagascar](#) and have recently published a range of new fold-out guides: [Primates of Malaysia](#), [Primates of Thailand](#), [Primates of Northeast Africa](#), and the second edition of [Primates of East Africa](#). Another noteworthy mammal book is [Small Mustelids](#) from HarperCollins, a new instalment in the New Naturalist series that is due in February. We furthermore have two herpetology titles: [The Reptiles of the Limpopo Province and Kruger National Park: Their Ecology, Behaviour and Distribution](#) is due from Herp Nomad in South Africa later this month, while Sy Montgomery's new book [Of Time and Turtles: Mending the World, Shell by Shattered Shell](#) will be published in November by Mariner Books.

For entomologists, a welcome addition is the [Field Guide to the Butterflies of Cyprus with Distribution Maps](#), due in October from Siri Scientific Press, which is an abridged and more affordable version of the earlier [Butterflies of Cyprus](#) published by CABI. NatureBureau has announced [The Bees of Sussex](#) for February while we have received stock of the second edition of [Ireland's Biodiversity: Dragonflies & Damselflies](#), an identification swatch of the National Biodiversity Data Centre in Ireland. We are also expecting stock of the Spanish butterfly field guide [Mariposas Diurnas de Canarias](#) from Turquesa Publicaciones.

Botanists can look out for [Hedges](#), the next volume in Bloomsbury's British Wildlife Collection, which is due in February. KNNV Uitgeverij in the Netherlands has recently published [Plant Galls of the Netherlands, Belgium and Luxembourg](#), and we are expecting stock of the Spanish Flora [Vascular de Canarias](#) from Turquesa Publicaciones.

On the subject of conservation and environmental issues, we have a range of titles. Columbia University Press recently published [Soil to Foil: Aluminum and the Quest for Industrial Sustainability](#), while Cambridge University Press will publish Dieter Helm's [Legacy: How to Build the Sustainable Economy](#) in November. Two titles due in February are [The Last of Its Kind: The Search for the Great Auk and the Discovery of Extinction](#) from Princeton University Press and [Effects of Climate Change on Insects: Physiological, Evolutionary, and Ecological Responses](#) from Oxford University Press.

Lastly, a miscellany of titles covers ecology, with [Effective Ecology: Seeking Success in a Hard Science](#) from CRC Press, out now, and the paperback of [Scientist: E. O. Wilson: A Life in Nature](#) due in October from Vintage; natural history, with the second edition of [Crossbill Guide: Lanzarote and Fuerteventura, Spain](#) due in November from KNNV Uitgeverij; and nature writing, with the paperback of [The Golden Mole: and Other Living Treasure](#) due in November from Faber & Faber
