Welcome to the September 2024 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open this month with mycology as we are pleased to announce that NHBS will be distributing Paul Whelan's 2-volume set [Lichens of Ireland & Great Britain: A Visual Guide to Their Identification](#). Also of interest is the new FSC fold-out guide [Distinctive Grassland Fungi](#). For botanists, we have [The Forest Guide Wales: Copses, Woods and Forests](#) and the second edition of [Harrap's Wild Flowers: A Field Guide to the Wild Flowers of Britain & Ireland](#), both due in February from Bloomsbury publishing.

Mammalogists have three noteworthy books to look out for. Bloomsbury will publish [Field Guide to Mammals of Madagascar](#), written by Nick Garbutt, in February. Lynx Edicions has announced [Neotropical Primates](#) for September as part of their Lynx Illustrated Checklists Collection. And for readers interested in wolves [The Ellesmere Wolves: Behavior and Ecology in the High Arctic](#) is due in February from the University of Chicago Press. This, to our knowledge, is the first book on this remote wolf population.

For birdwatchers, we have several smaller pocket guides. Dave Gosney has just published [Finding Birds in Eastern Andalusia](#) and [Finding Birds in Western Andalusia](#), and Bloomsbury announced [RSPB ID Spotlight: Birds of Towns and Cities](#) for February. A title of local interest to Devon is the third edition of [Birds of the Salcombe & Kingsbridge Estuary](#).

Rounding up other animal groups, herpetologists will want to check out [Amphibians of Ecuador, Volume 2: Pipidae, Telmatobiidae, Microhylidae, Dendrobatidae, Ranidae, Bufonidae, and Hylidae](#), which is due in February from CRC Press and part of an ongoing series; for entomologists, we have [Composition and Nature of the Culicidae \(Mosquitoes\)](#), due in November from CABI; and for arachnologists there is [Pocket Guide to British Spiders](#), due in January from Bloomsbury Publishing and illustrated by the inimitable Richard Lewington.

Two wildlife conservation titles are [Night Vision and Daylight Camera Systems for Wildlife: A Practical Guide](#), due in February from Pelagic Publishing, and [Lost Wonders: 10 Tales of Extinction from the 21st Century](#), due in November from Picador. For ethologists, there is the third edition of [Animal Tool Behavior: The Use and Manufacture of Tools by Animals](#), due in February from Johns Hopkins University Press. Environmental historians will want to check out [An Environmental History of France: Making the Landscape, 1770-2020](#), due in November from Bloomsbury Academic.

A final miscellany of books includes two art and photography books, [Jay Matternes: Paleoartist and Wildlife Painter](#) from Abbeville Press and [Wildlife Photographer of the Year, Portfolio 34](#), due in October from the London Natural History Museum; and the outdoor guide [Walking Safaris of Africa: Guided Walks from the Cape to Kenya](#), due in February from Pelagic Publishing.
