# September 2025 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the September 2025 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a strong list of bird books this month. Helm is publishing the second edition of its Helm Identification Guide Nightjars of the World in February, 26 years after the first edition in 2000. We have several field guides to overseas destinations: Birds of Jamaica and the second edition of Birds of the Indian Subcontinent are both due in February from Helm, while John Beaufoy is releasing the third edition

of A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of the Philippines in January. Closer to home, the next instalment of The Birdwatcher's Yearbook is making its return in a much-expanded format. With this guide coming under new editorship, the 2026 edition will feature almost double the number of reserves by including regions and counties that have previously been overlooked.

For other vertebrates, we have a few books each. Two interesting mammal titles are

Bats of the World: A Guide to Every Family, due in February from Princeton University Press, and the third and final volume of the Spanish language mammal fauna Mamíferos de Argentina, Tomo 3: Roedores, that has just been published by Ediciones La Biblioteca del Naturalista. For herpetologists, we have a mix of titles. John Beaufoy is publishing A Field Guide to the Reptiles and Amphibians of Singapore in September, CRC Press has published the paperback of Evolutionary Ecology of Amphibians, and the Society for the Study of Amphibians and Reptiles (SSAR) has recently released the hefty

J.G. Schneider's Historiae Amphibiorum: Herpetology at the Dawn of the 19th Century, which will be of interest to science historians as well.

Turning to invertebrates, we have three recently published books relevant to entomologists: the fold-out <a href="Guide to Distinctive Terrestrial Beetles of Britain and Ireland">Guide to Distinctive Terrestrial Beetles of Britain and Ireland</a> from the Field Studies Council, and two academic titles: <a href="Insect Anatomy">Insect Anatomy</a>: Structure and Function from Academy Press, and <a href="Essential Insect Physiology">Essential Insect Physiology</a>: A Textbook for Undergraduates and Graduates from CRC Press. Other invertebrate groups covered this month are arachnids, with John Beaufoy having published <a href="A Naturalist's Guide to the Spiders of Borneo">A Naturalist's Guide to the Spiders of Borneo</a>, and molluscs, with the privately published <a href="Nudibranchs and Other Sea Slugs from the Gold Coast, Southern Queensland">Nudibranchs and Other Sea Slugs from the Gold Coast, Southern Queensland</a>, Australia.

For botanists, we have a diverse spread of books. Turquesa Publicaciones has released Flora and Vegetation of El Hierro, Canary Islands: Nature Guide, while in October, Octopus Publishing Group will release A Wildflower Year: A Guide to Wildflowers, their Habitats & Histories and Weidenfeld & Nicolson will release the paperback of The Tree Hunters: How the Cult of the Arboretum Transformed Our Landscape. Mycologists will want to take note of

Puffballs, Earthstars, Stinkhorns, and Other Gasteroid Fungi of Eastern North America, published by the University of Texas Press and authored by the very productive team of Alan and Arleen Bessette and co-authors.

Our selection of conservation titles skews towards the academic side this month. Oxford University Press has released the third edition of

Conservation of Wildlife Populations: Applications of Ecological, Evolutionary, and Genetic Concepts just now and will publish

The Agreement on Marine Biodiversity of Areas Beyond National Jurisdiction: Commentary and Analysis in November. Wiley has announced

Wetlands of Tropical and Subtropical South and Central America: Biodiversity, Livelihoods and Conservation for January, while Academic Press will release Conserving Migratory Species: An Interdisciplinary Synthesis in March. Lighter reading is provided by the paperback of

Our Oaken Bones: Reviving a Family, a Farm and Britain's Ancient Rainforests, which is due in February from Witness Books.

A final tranche of titles covers diverse topics. Two general natural history titles due in February are the US-centric Ponds: An Illustrated Guide from Yale University Press, and the second edition of RSPB Nature Tracking: How to Interpret Animal Tracks and Signs from Bloomsbury Publishing. Two statistical guides are Statistical Models for Wildlife Survey Data, due in February from Springer, and Statistics and Data Handling for Biologists: A Student's Guide, due in November from Pelagic Publishing. Finally, two thought-provoking works of narrative non-fiction are the paperback reissues of The Forbidden Garden of Leningrad: A True Story of Science and Sacrifice in a City under Siege, out now from Sceptre, and Walking Europe's Last Wilderness: A Journey through the Carpathian Mountains, due in March from Yale University Press.
