Welcome to the October 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

There is a smattering of new fauna titles across the different groups. The Vincent Wildlife Trust will publish the seventh edition of their booklet [The Bats of Britain and Ireland](#) in November while John Beaufoy will publish the second edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Mammals of India](#) in October. This month also marks the annual return of [The Birdwatcher's Yearbook](#) from Calluna Books – this trusted resource is now in its 43rd edition. The Lancashire & Cheshire Fauna Society has just published the [Lancashire Bird Report 2021](#), which is in stock. Princeton University Press has announced two new titles due in March: [Snakes of the World: A Guide to Every Family](#), authored by well-known professor of herpetology Mark O'Shea, and [The Lives of Beetles](#), part of their new series [The Lives of the Natural World](#).

For botanists, we have some really exciting titles to announce. Princeton University Press will publish the 2-volume [Plant Atlas 2020: Mapping Changes in the Distribution of the British and Irish Flora](#) in March, which is published in association with the Botanical Society of Britain and Ireland. Building on past efforts of the BSBI in the twentieth century, this is the most in-depth survey of British and Irish flora ever undertaken. Later this month we are expecting stock of the brand-new [A Field Guide to Bryophytes](#) from The Species Recovery Trust. Looking ahead, The University of Chicago Press will publish [Trees and Forests of Tropical Asia: Exploring Tapovan](#) in November, and Princeton University Press will publish [The Hidden Company That Trees Keep: Life from Treetops to Root Tips](#) in March. Lastly, the Argentine Instituto Multidisciplinario de Biología Vegetal (CONICET-UNC) has just announced the latest addition to their ongoing Spanish-language series Flora Vascular de la República Argentina: [Volume 19\(3\), Dicotyledoneae: Boraginales, Caryophyllales \(p.p.\), Gentianales \(p.p.\)](#). Remember that you can set up a standing order for any series we sell and either be notified of or automatically receive new volumes when they are published. On the topic of conservation, two books due in March are [Ravenous: Why Our Appetite Is Killing Us and the Planet, and What We Can Do About It](#) from Profile Books and the paperback of [Wild Fell: Fighting for Nature on a Lake District Hill Farm](#) from Transworld Publishers. Related to this and providing historical perspective, Patagonia Books has just reissued John Perlin's classic [The Forest Journey: The Role of Trees in the Fate of Civilization](#) which was originally published in 1986 and updated in 2005.

For evolutionary biologists and palaeontologists, two noteworthy titles are [Imperfection: A Natural History](#), due in October from MIT Press, and [Remnants of Ancient Life: The New Science of Old Fossils](#), due in March from Princeton University Press.

Finally, three miscellaneous titles are [How to Publish in Biological Sciences: A Guide for the Uninitiated](#), which has just been published by CRC Press and offers a welcome change of focus. Rather than offering hands-on advice on how to write a scientific paper, it considers all the challenges of the modern publishing landscape that are relevant before and after the writing process and reflects on good practice in academic publishing. Lastly, for readers interested in drawing and journaling, we have two new titles from Natural Selection Press due this month: [Nature Journaling for a Wild Life](#) and [Master of Field Arts](#). The author, Roseann Beggy Hanson, is both an artist and seasoned expedition and conservation consultant.
