October 2023 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the October 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open with a fantastic line-up of bird books. Pelagic Publishing has just three relevant books, namely Bird Pellets: A Complete Photographic Guide, due in March; Purposeful Birdwatching: Getting to Know Birds Better, due in February; and <a href="The Vanishing Mew Gull: A Guide to the Bird Names of the Western Palaearctic, due in March. Bloomsbury has announced the third edition of the Helm Field Guide Birds of the Middle East, due in March; and the second edition of The RSPB Everyday Guide to British Birds, due in February. Other noteworthy titles are Seabirds in Britain and Ireland (2015–2021), due in December from Lynx; The Birdwatcher's Yearbook 2024 from Calluna Books, out this month; and the privately published This Iconic Bird, written by Neville Davies.

For other vertebrate groups, we have five titles. Herpetologists will be interested in The Snakes of Laos of Edition Chimaira, which at over 950 pages looks to be the definitive work on the subject, while Ediciones La Biblioteca del Naturalista has just published Snakes of Argentina: Complete Guide, and we have now received stock of <a href="The Reptiles of the Limpopo Province and Kruger National Park: Their Ecology, Behaviour and Distribution. For fish-workers we have two books on sharks that are both in stock now: the new FSC fold-out guide Shark and Skate Eggcases and Great White Sharks of the Mediterranean: In Search of the Great White Shark's Origin from Caracal Publishing.

For entomologists we have a glut of Lepidoptera books with <u>A Field Guide to the Butterflies of Romania</u>, due in April from Pelagic Publishing; <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies of Borneo: Sabah, Sarawak, Brunei and Kalimantan</u>, out now from John Beaufoy Publishing; <u>A Preliminary Guide to the Pyralid Moths of Borneo, Part 2</u>, out now from Natural History Publications Borneo; and <u>Papilionidae Part 4 (Guide to the Butterflies of the Palearctic Region): Subfamily Papilioninae, Tribe Papilionini, Genus Papilio (Partim), out now from Omnes Artes. Princeton University Press has announced <u>Velvet Ants of North America</u> for February. For other invertebrate groups, there is the second edition of the <u>Field Guide to the Spiders of South Africa</u> from Struik Nature and the photographic work <u>Secrets of the Octopus</u> by Sy Montgomery from National Geographic both of which are due in March.</u>

Botanists will want to take a look at the 850-page reference work <u>Flowering Plant Families of Southern Africa</u>, out now from the South African National Biodiversity Institute; <u>Pathless Forest: The Quest to Save the World's Biggest Flowers</u>, due in February from Allen Lane; and the paperback of <u>The Orchid Outlaw: On a Mission to Save Britain's Rarest Flowers</u>, due in March from John Murray. For mycologists, we have a specialist work with the posthumously published <u>Descriptive</u>, <u>Illustrated Keys to the World's Myxomycetes</u>, published in Spain by Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas.

On the subject of conservation biology and other environmental issues, we have a broad selection this month. Out now are the second edition of <u>Ecological Restoration and Environmental Change: Renewing Damaged Ecosystems</u> from Routledge and <u>The End of Eden: Wild Nature in the Age of Climate Breakdown</u> from Bloomsbury. Coming later this year are <u>Emerging Zoonotic and Wildlife Pathogens: Disease Ecology, Epidemiology, and Conservation</u>, due in December from Oxford University Press; and <u>Conservation</u>, due in March from Bloomsbury. Lastly, there is a trio of paperback reissues: <u>The Climate Book</u>, coming in February from Penguin Books; <u>Emerging Zoonotic and Wildlife Pathogens: Disease Ecology, Epidemiology, and Conservation</u>, due in March from Bloomsbury. Lastly, there is a trio of paperback reissues: <u>The Climate Book</u>, coming in February from Penguin Books; and

Half-Earth Socialism: A Plan to Save the Future from Extinction, Climate Change, and Pandemics, coming in April from Verso Books.

Finally, a miscellary of titles includes two very practical titles,
