October 2024 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the October 2024 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a great line-up of bird titles to start with. Richard Sale has just finished the second edition of his monograph The Peregrine Falcon which has been substantially revised and expanded with innovative new research. Calluna Books is releasing The Birdwatcher's Yearbook 2025 and we just received stock of the Lancashire Bird Report 2023 from the Lancashire & Cheshire Fauna Society. Further afield, two noteworthy field guides are A Photographic Field Guide to the Birds of the Himalayas and South Assam Hills and A Photographic Field Guide to the Birds of South India from Om Books International.

Turning to other vertebrate groups, we have a few titles each. Bloomsbury has announced the third edition of Field Guide to Mammals of Europe, North Africa and the Middle East for January while Princeton University Press will publish The Lives of Bats: A Global Natural History in March (part of The Lives of the Natural World series). In that same series, Princeton will also publish two herpetological titles:

The Lives of Frogs: A Natural History and The Lives of Snakes: A Natural History of the World's Snakes, both due in March. Lastly, we have Shark: The Illustrated Biography, due in March from Princeton University Press as well.

For entomologists, we have several noteworthy books that have just been published. From NAP Editions comes Beetles of Europe, Volume 2: Polyphaga: Scarabs, Cockchafers, Rove Beetles, Hydrophiloid Beetles; the Field Studies Council released Click-beetles of Great Britain and Ireland: An Atlas and Natural History; and Owlfly Publishing informed us about The Cicadas of North America. In March, Princeton University Press will publish Dragonflies and Damselflies of the World: A Guide to Their Diversity. In the category of other invertebrates, we have Southern African Sea Slugs published by the Southern Underwater Research Group.

On the subject of botany, readers can look forward to

The Forbidden Garden of Leningrad: A True Story of Science and Sacrifice in a City under Siege, due in November from Sceptre, which tells the remarkable story of the world's first seed bank. Penguin Books will publish the paperback of Pathless Forest: The Quest to Save the World's Largest Flowers in March while the Field Studies Council has just published their new fold-out guide Autumn Fruits and Seeds.

Turning to wildlife conservation there are a large number of titles of note this month. Bloomsbury will publish Tim Birkhead's next book The Great Auk: Its Extraordinary Life, Hideous Death and Mysterious Afterlife in March while New Island Books has just published Future Wild: Nature Restoration in Ireland. There are a substantial number of reissues and paperback releases in the pipeline. Henry Holt has published the 10th-anniversary edition of Elizabeth Kolbert's The Sixth Extinction: An Unnatural History while Earthscan has released the paperback of the Routledge Handbook of Rewilding. In 2025, there will be paperback reissues of Bloomsbury's Groundbreakers: The Return of Britain's Wild Boar (March), HarperNorth's Nature's Ghosts: The World We Lost and How to Bring It Back (March), and Pelagic Publishing's Ancient Woods, Trees & Forests: Ecology, History and Management (April).

Three upcoming titles revolve around habitats. Princeton University Press is expanding on the concept introduced with its 2021 Habitats of the World guide and has announced <u>Habitats of North America</u> and <u>Habitats of Africa</u> for February. Meanwhile, Pelagic Publishing will release <u>European Deserts: Sandy Wilderness on a Green Continent in March.</u>

A final miscellany of two titles includes

Walking Europe's Last Wilderness: A Journey through the Carpathian Mountains, due in February from Yale

University Press, and the paperback of Radical by Nature: The Revolutionary Life of Alfred Russel Wallace, due in March from Princeton University Press.
