#### November 2022 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the November 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have a number of exciting bird titles this month. Pelagic Publishing has announced The Green Woodpecker: The Natural and Cultural History of Picus viridis for March, while Princeton will release Birds of Belize and Field Guide to North American Flycatchers: Empidonax and Pewees in April. There are two paperback rereleases in March: Birds and Us: A 12,000 Year History, from Cave Art to Conservation from Penguin Books and When There Were Birds: The Forgotten History of Our Connections from Abacus. Dave Gosney of Easybirder has just published two new additions to his Finding Birds series: Finding Birds in Corsica and Finding Birds in Languedoc-Roussillon. Lastly, we now carry stock of Berkshire's Birdscapes 1947-2022.

Several noteworthy herpetology titles were added last month. Penclen Edition has just released the large, 3rd edition of <u>Salamanders & Newts of the World</u>. The previous two editions were written in French, but the book has now been translated into English and expanded even further to over 1100 pages. Similarly large in scope is <u>Amphibians and Reptiles of Wisconsin</u>, just released by the University of Wisconsin Press. Meanwhile, Edition Chimaira has just released <u>Australasian Elapids</u>: <u>Husbandry</u>, <u>Captive Care and Ecology</u> and has announced <u>Amphibians and Reptiles of Russia for February</u>.

Entomologists will want to take a look at the third edition of Britain's Hoverflies, due in April from WILDGuides, and

Butterflies of the United Arab Emirates Including Northern Oman from Motivate Media Group, which is now in stock. Interesting natural history titles are

The Lives of Butterflies: A Natural History of Our Planet's Butterfly Life, due in April from Princeton University Press;

Meetings with Moths: Discovering their Mystery and Extraordinary Lives, due in April from Fourth Estate; and the paperback of

Endless Forms: The Secret World of Wasps, due in March from HarperCollins. Regarding other invertebrates, there is A Photographic Guide To Singapore Spiders, just published by the National Parks Board Singapore.

We have a large list of biodiversity and conservation ethics-themed books this month. Chicago Review Press will publish

Among Tigers: Fighting to Bring Back Asia's Big Cats in November while Pelagic Publishing is pulling out the stops next year with

Treated Like Animals: Improving the Lives of the Creatures We Own, Eat and Use due in February, Big Bat Year: A Conservation Story due in March, and

Reconnection: Fixing our Broken Relationship with Nature due in April. That month will also see The Biodiversity Gardener: Establishing a Legacy for the Natural World

from Princeton University Press and the paperback rerelease of In Search of One Last Song: Britain's Disappearing Birds and the People Trying to Save Them

from HarperCollins.

There are several interesting palaeontology and evolution titles in the pipeline. CRC Press has announced Evolution of the Ammonoids for December while paperback rereleases are coming of The Sloth Lemur's Song: Madagascar from the Deep Past to the Uncertain Present (March, from HarperCollins) and Different: What Apes Can Teach Us About Gender (April, from Granta). Lastly, we just received stock of the privately published "Evolutionary Edition" of On the Origin of Species. This is a neat project that cleverly uses typography and printing to show how Darwin's book developed over the different editions.

Finally, a short list of miscellaneous titles includes <u>The Forest Guide: Copses, Woods and Forests of Scotland</u>, due in April from Bloomsbury; <u>Invisible Friends: How Microbes Shape our Lives and the World around Us</u>, due in March from Pelagic Publishing; and the paperback rerelease of <u>The Wild Isles: An Anthology of the Best of British & Irish Nature Writing</u>, due in December from Head of Zeus.
