November 2023 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the November 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open this month with a selection of books on vertebrates. Three upcoming bird field guides

are A Field Guide to the Birds of Malaysia: Including Sabah and Sarawak, due in March from John Beaufoy;

Where to Watch Birds in Southeast England: Essex, London and Kent; and RSPB Birds of the British Isles, both of which are due in April from Bloomsbury. Princeton University Press has announced the second edition of <u>Avian Architecture: How Birds Design, Engineer, and Build</u> for February. On the subject of herpetology, we have two noteworthy books due in April: <u>Tortoises of the World</u>: <u>Giants to Dwarfs</u> from Johns Hopkins University Press and <u>Frogs of the World</u>: A <u>Guide to Every Family</u> from Princeton University Press. Lastly, Bloomsbury will release the second edition of <u>Marine Life of the Mediterranean in April</u>.

On the subject of invertebrates, we have some exciting and unusual guides. Entomologists can look out for the paperback of <u>A Dipterist's Handbook</u> from the Amateur Entomologists' Society, available now. Princeton University Press has announced two further additions to their Guides to Every Family series, both due in April: <u>Wasps of the World: A Guide to Every Family and Shells of the World: A Natural History</u>. A more specialist mollusc book of interest is <u>A Guide to the Hunter Shells, Volume 2: The Streptaxoidea: The Ennienae, Orthogibbinae, Marconiinae, Odontartemoninae, Streptaxinae and the Diapheridae</u> from ConchBooks, available now. Lastly, we have books on marine and freshwater invertebrates more generally with <u>Plankton: A Worldwide Guide</u>, due in April from Princeton University Press, and two self-published practical guides for microscopists that are in stock now: <u>A Beginners Guide to Freshwater Microscopic Life</u> and An Illustrated Guide to the Freshwater Protozoa.

For botanists, we have four excellent titles. Kew Botanic Gardens has just announced Palms of New Guinea, due in March; Pelagic Publishing will release A Field Guide to Urban Plants: The Flora of Pavements, Walls and Waste Ground in April; and Broken Hill Publishers has revealed Atlas of the Hellenic Flora (3-Volume Set) for January. Already out for a while but only just brought to our attention is the second edition of Le Roux and Müller's Field Guide to the Trees & Shrubs of Namibia from Namibia Publishing House.

There are some really interesting titles on wildlife conservation and other environmental issues in the pipeline. Bloomsbury will publish <u>Groundbreakers: The Return of Britain's Wild Boar</u> in February and the paperback of <u>Fevered Planet: How Diseases Emerge When We Harm Nature</u> in April, while Chelsea Greene has announced Derek Gow's next book

Hunt for the Shadow Wolf: The Lost History of Wolves in Britain and the Myths and Stories That Surround Them, which is due in March. Two forthcoming titles on environmental politics are Oceans Rise, Empires Fall: Why Geopolitics Hastens Climate Catastrophe, due in February from Oxford University Press, and Long Problems: Climate Change and the Challenge of Governing across Time, due in April from Princeton University Press. Lastly, Atlantic Books will release the paperback of Masters of the Lost Land: The Untold Story of the Fight to Own the Amazon in January.

Three natural history titles that came to our attention are the privately published <u>Antarctica: A Bird's-Eye View</u>, which is in stock now; <u>Spectacular Britain: A Spotter's Guide to the UK's Most Amazing Natural Phenomena</u>, due in January from Conway Maritime Press; and the paperback of <u>The Swimmer: The Wild Life of Roger Deakin</u>, due in April from Penguin Books.

Finally, a miscellary of titles across the subject areas of respectively ecology, earth sciences, evolution, and environmental history. Princeton University Press has announced <u>The World Atlas of Rivers</u>, <u>Estuaries</u>, and <u>Deltas</u> for April, while the rest are paperback reissues: <u>Blue Machine: How the Ocean Shapes Our World</u>, due in May from Penguin Books; <u>Imperfection: A Natural History</u>, due in February from MIT Press; and <u>The Earth Transformed: An Untold History</u>, due in April from Bloomsbury.
