# November 2024 Monthly Catalogue

Welcome to the November 2024 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have several titles for each of the various animal groups. Bloomsbury will publish <u>Mammals of Iberia: Terrestrial Mammals of Spain, Portugal and the Balearic Islands</u> in February while Whittles Publishing has just released the second edition of <u>Otters of the World</u>. Birdwatchers and ornithologists have three titles to look out for: Lynx has announced <u>Birds That Leave Their Mark: Tracks and Signs of Southern European Birds</u> for November, Pelagic Publishing will release <u>Field Guide to the Birds of North America</u> in February, and Princeton University Press will publish <u>Birds at Rest: The Behavior and Ecology of Avian Sleep</u> in April. For herpetologists, we have <u>Threatened Newts and Salamanders, Volume 4: Captive Care Management</u> from Edition Chimaira. Lastly, entomologists can look forward to <u>The Butterflies of London</u> from NatureBureau and <u>Microlepidoptera of Europe, Volume 10: Depressariida from Brill, both due in December.</u>

We have a diverse selection of titles for botanists this month. Two forthcoming titles are <u>Europe's Alpine Flowers: A Field Guide</u> from WILDGuides and the third edition of <u>A Naturalist's Guide to the Wild Flowers of Britain</u> from John Beaufoy, both of which are due in April. <u>Begonia of the Philippines: A Photographic Guide to Selected Philippine Species of Begonia</u>, published by KBCC Press, is available now. Notably, we have a range of French floras this month. The Senckenbergische Naturforschende Gesellschaft in Germany will publish a French flora to Burkina Faso and Mali in November, <u>Flore Illustrée du Burkina Faso et du Mali</u>. PUL Diffusion in Canada has completed their ongoing flora of Quebec and Labrador with the publication of <u>Flore Nordique du Québec et du Labrador</u>, <u>Volume 4</u> and <u>Flore Nordique du Québec et du Labrador</u>, <u>Volume 5</u>. Lastly, BIOTOPE in France has announced the second volume of their bryophyte flora for November, Les Bryophytes de France, Tome 2: Pleurocarpes et Sphagnales.

For mycologists, we have two titles of note: the Monmouthshire Meadows Group has announced the third edition of <u>Grassland Fungi</u>: A <u>Field Guide</u> for March, while the Belgian Association des Mycologues Francophones de Belgique has published the sixth edition of <u>Microscopy & Fungi</u> which is the first English-language edition after the previous five French ones.

On the subject of conservation, we have four titles. Witness Books (an imprint of Ebury Press) has announced Our Oaken Bones: Reviving a Family, a Farm and Britain's Ancient Rainforests for March. The charity People, Landscape and Cultural Environment of Yorkshire has just released Saving May Moss: 50 Years Conservation on a North York Moors Peat Bog. Two guides to national parks are Parks and Nature Reserves of Europe, published by Siri Scientific Press, and the bilingual English/French The Protected Areas of Isalo and Zombitse-Vohibasia in Central Southwestern Madagascar, published by Association Vahatra.

Finally, two books with a palaeontology or deep-time perspective are the paperback rereleases of <u>Remnants of Ancient Life: The New Science of Old Fossils</u>, due in March from Princeton University Press, and <u>Walking the Bones of Britain: A 3 Billion Year Journey from the Outer Hebrides to the Thames Estuary</u>, published recently by Transworld Publishers.
