Welcome to the November 2025 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

The big news this month is that Lynx is publishing the [Handbook of the Reptiles of the World, Volume 1: Turtles and Crocodiles](#) in early 2026. The first of a planned seven volumes, this new series will feature the same format and high production values as their earlier Handbook of the Birds of the World and Handbook of the Mammals of the World. We invite customers to place a standing order with us to ensure they will receive each new volume as it is published. A few other books of interest to herpetologists are the seventh edition of [A Complete Guide to Reptiles of Australia](#), recently published by New Holland, and the bilingual English-Italian [Atlas of Italian Amphibians and Reptiles](#), published by Edizioni Belvedere. This same publisher also just published the bilingual [Atlas of Mammals in Italy](#).

We have a range of bird books. Of particular relevance to recorders and other fieldworkers is [How to Count Birds: A Guide for Monitoring Avian Populations](#), due in April from Johns Hopkins University Press. Another exceptional title is [The Seabirds of Greenland](#), published in Denmark by Alle Alle Publishing, for which we now have stock. There are a number of affordable field guides coming next year. Christopher Helm will release [Birds of Peninsular Malaysia and Singapore](#) in February, while in April, John Beaufoy will release the fourth edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Birds of Malaysia](#) and the third edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to Garden Birds of Britain and Ireland](#). Meanwhile, the Bristol Ornithological Club has published the [Avon Bird Report 2024](#). Two paperback rereleases coming from HarperCollins in April are Adam Nicolson's [Bird School: A Beginner in the Wood](#) and Jon Gower's [Birdland: A Journey Around Britain on the Wing](#).

A rare practical title on fish is [Identification of Fishes by Their Otoliths in 3D: English Channel and North Sea](#), translated into English from the French original by Editions Quae. Another first-of-its-kind fish book is [Archer Fish Biology](#), the paperback of which will be published in November by Science Publishers.

We have several books on insects and other invertebrates in the pipeline. Pelagic Publishing will release [Seashore Plankton: A Practical Introduction to Biology and Identification](#) in March. Two upcoming insect field guides are the sixth edition of [Field Guide to the Dragonflies & Damselflies of Great Britain and Ireland](#), due in April from Bloomsbury, and the second edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies of Britain & Northern Europe](#), due in April from John Beaufoy. More scholarly works are the third edition of [Identification and Geographical Distribution of the Mosquitoes of North America, North of Mexico](#), due in March from The University Press of Florida; the [Distribution Atlas of Grasshoppers and Praying Mantises in Germany](#), just published by Eugen Ulmer Verlag; and [Australian Moths: A Natural History](#), due in March from CABI Publishing.

For botanists, we can announce three books on trees that are in the pipeline. Bloomsbury is publishing [The Forest Guide England: Copses, Woods and Forests](#) in January and [RSPB Trees of the British Isles](#) in March, while Allen Lane is publishing Suzanne Simard's new book [When the Forest Breathes: Renewal and Resilience in the Natural World](#) in March. There are several additions to ongoing floras, such as [Flora of Ecuador, Volume 99, Part 198: Triuridaceae, Part 207A: Burmanniaceae, Part 207B: Thismiaceae](#), from the Botanical Institute, Goteborg University; [Flora Zambesiaca, Volume 6, Part 4: Compositae](#), from the Royal Botanic Garden, Kew; and the Spanish-language [Flora Mesoamericana, Volume 2 \(Part 1\): Cycadaceae a Cactaceae](#), due in January from Missouri Botanical Garden Press. For mycologists, the Field Studies Council has just published another fold-out guide illustrated by Geoffrey Kibby: [Distinctive Fungi on Wood](#).

On the topic of wildlife conservation and other environmental issues, we have the second edition of [Wildlife Gardening for Everyone and Everything](#), due in March from Bloomsbury; and paperback rereleases of [Uncommon Ground: Rethinking Our Relationship With the Countryside](#), due in April from HarperCollins, and of Sir

David Attenborough's [Ocean: Earth's Last Wilderness](#), due in April from John Murray.

On the subject of palaeontology and evolutionary biology, we have three books. Siri Scientific Press has just published [Journey through the Cenozoic: Tetrapod Faunas 66 Million Years in the Making](#), a remarkable who-is-who to the animals that succeeded the dinosaurs, Pelagic Publishing will release [The Ascent of Mammals: How DNA Discoveries are Rewriting our Story](#) in March, and Princeton University Press has announced [The Descent of Man: An Annotated Edition of Darwin's Classic Work](#). Based on editor James T. Costa's earlier annotated versions of key works by Darwin and Wallace, this will be a very thorough and welcome addition.

A final trio of books covers natural history more generally. Bloomsbury will publish [Where to Watch Wildlife in Britain by Low-Carbon Transport](#), due in January, and [The Great British River: A Guide to Our Waterways and River Wildlife](#), due in April. Penguin has announced the paperback of [Nature's Memory: Behind the Scenes at the World's Natural History Museums](#) for release in April.
