Welcome to the December 2022 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We open this month with several vertebrate groups, starting with birds. We just received stock of Richard Sale and Steve Watson's latest book, [The Peregrine Falcon](#). Several other notable bird books are due in May, including [Birds of Costa Rica](#) from Princeton University Press, [The Painted Stork: Exploring Ecology and Conservation in India](#) from Pelagic Publishing, and [RSPB ID Spotlight: Birds of Farmland & Open Countryside](#) from Bloomsbury. Turning to mammals, Princeton University Press will publish [The Lion: Behavior, Ecology, and Conservation of an Iconic Species](#) in May while [The Natural History of Primates: A Systematic Survey of Ecology and Behavior](#) from Rowman & Littlefield is available now. Finally, two books covering these groups and more are the second edition of the bilingual [Field Guide to Wildlife of the Pantanal: Illustrated Checklist with Geography](#), which is available now, and [Tooth and Claw: Top Predators of the World](#), due in May from Princeton University Press.

We have an excellent range of titles on insects and other invertebrates this month. [Stick and Leaf-Insects of the World: Phasmids](#) has just been published by NAP Editions. Atropos has announced [A Guide to the Pyralid and Crambid Moths of Britain and Ireland](#) for December while Princeton University Press has announced more May releases with [Insects of North America](#) and [Common Bees of Western North America](#). Also due in May is the second edition of [A Naturalist's Guide to the Butterflies of Australia](#) from John Beaufoy, [RSPB ID Spotlight: Ladybirds](#) from Bloomsbury, and the second edition of [Nudibranchs of Britain, Ireland and Northwest Europe](#) from Wild Nature Press.

The update for botanists is short but sweet this month. Pelagic Publishing has announced [Frustrating Flowers & Puzzling Plants: Identifying the Difficult Species of Britain and Ireland](#) for May which will be a welcome addition to the many flower field guides already on the market. Speaking of which, WILDGuides is releasing [British & Irish Wild Flowers and Plants: A Pocket Guide](#) in April. Lastly, for Dutch botanists, [the second instalment in the ongoing Nova Flora Neerlandica](#) is due in December from KNNV Uitgeverij and will cover the sedges.

On the topic of wildlife conservation and other environmental issues, we have a diverse assortment. Well-known bat researcher Merlin Tuttle has just written [The Bat House Guide](#) which is published by Greenleaf Book Group Press and is available now. Two forthcoming titles from Bloomsbury Publishing are [The Deadly Balance: Predators and People in a Crowded World](#), due in February on their Sigma imprint; and [The Book of Wilding: A Practical Guide to Rewilding, Big and Small](#) by Wilding author Isabella Tree and her partner Charlie Burrell, which is due in May. [Pathways to Success: Taking Conservation to Scale in Complex Systems](#), published earlier this year by Island Press, is an interesting title for conservation professionals, while [Failing Forward: The Rise and Fall of Neoliberal Conservation](#), due in April from the University of California Press, delivers a critique of market-based conservation approaches. Two titles dealing with climate change are [Outsourcing Climate Breakdown: How Rich Nations Get Away With It](#), due in May from Manchester University Press, and the paperback of [Hurricane Lizards and Plastic Squid: How the Natural World is Adapting to Climate Change](#), due in February from Icon Books.

Finally, a smattering of titles covers a range of subjects. Jonathan Kingdon returns to the topic of human evolution in [Origin Africa: A Natural History](#), due in April from HarperCollins, while Princeton University Press will publish [Radical by Nature: The Revolutionary Life of Alfred Russel Wallace](#) in March. An interesting popular science title covering biochemistry is the paperback of [Transformer: The Deep Chemistry of Life and Death](#), due in May from Profile Books. Finally, Pelagic publishing is releasing two radically different books in May: regional natural history is covered by [Countryside History: Essays in Honour of Oliver Rackham](#) while scientists embarking on data analysis will want to check out [An Introduction to R: Data Analysis and Visualization](#).
