Welcome to the December 2023 edition of the NHBS Monthly Catalogue, which lists all new titles added to our website in the last month.

We have an exceptionally large list of ornithological publications this month. Major announcements are the [Field Guide to North American Flycatchers: Kingbirds and Myiarchus](#), which is the second such volume, and [The Shorebirds of North America: A Natural History and Photographic Celebration](#), both due in May from Princeton University Press; and the [Identification Atlas of the Continental Birds of Southwestern Europe](#), due this month from Tundra Ediciones. Other overseas bird books are [Birds of the Mascarenes](#), privately published by Narainsamy Ramen; the second edition of [A Guide to the Birds of the Chagos Archipelago](#), just published by NatureBureau; and two further volumes from Dave Gosney: [Finding Birds in Southern Croatia](#) and [Finding Birds in Montenegro and Herzegovina](#). For UK birders, we have [Bird Tracks: A Field Guide to British Species](#), due in April from The History Press; [Where to Watch Birds in Surrey & Sussex](#), due in February from Helm; [RSPB ID Spotlight: Birds of Heath, Moor and Mountain](#), due in May from Bloomsbury; and the [Avon Bird Report 2022](#), just published by the Bristol Ornithological Club. Lastly, two paperback reprints are [Around the World in 80 Birds](#), due in April from Laurence King, and [Wild Air: In Search of Birdsong](#), due in May from Fourth Estate.

For other fauna, we have a diverse range of books. On amphibians, we have [A Guide to the Tadpoles of Borneo](#), privately published by the authors. For entomologists, we have [The Ant Collective: Inside the World of an Ant Colony](#), due in May from Princeton University Press, and [Parasitoid Wasps of South East Asia](#), out now from CABI. On molluscs, we have [Carrier Shells - Garbage Collectors of the Oceans: A Portrait of the Gastropod Family Xenophoridae](#), out now from ConchBooks. Lastly, on other marine invertebrates, we have the French book [Guide des Tuniciers de l'Europe de l'Ouest: Atlantique & Méditerranée \[Guide to Western European Tunicates: Atlantic and Mediterranean\]](#), out now from M&L Éditions.

On the subject of conservation biology and environmental issues, we can announce [Conservation Leadership: A Practical Guide](#), due in April from Earthscan; [Nature's Ghosts: A History – and Future – of the Natural World](#), due in May from HarperCollins; [Not the End of the World: How We Can Be the First Generation to Build a Sustainable Planet](#), due in January from Chatto & Windus; and the paperback of [Stuck Monkey: The Deadly Planetary Cost of the Things We Love](#), due in April from Apollo.

Two important ecology titles are [Common Ecology](#), out now from the International Ecology Institute, and [Behavioural Responses to a Changing World: Challenges and Applications](#), due in May from Oxford University Press.

Finally, a smattering of titles cover, respectively, palaeontology, geology, history of science, and nature writing. Princeton University Press has announced the third edition of [The Princeton Field Guide to Dinosaurs](#) for May. Oxford University Press has announced [This Volcanic Isle: The Violent Processes That Forged the British Landscape](#), also for May. The Paris Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle has just released the bilingual [Cuvier's History of Natural Sciences, Volume 4](#). Lastly, Canongate will release the paperback of [Beastly: A New History of Animals and Us](#) in May.
